## Waupun Common Council Minutes of Meeting from April 9, 2019

Mayor calls to order at 6pm.

Pledge of Allegiance is heard and followed by a moment of silence.

Board members present on roll call are Nickel, Vossekuil, Kaczmarski, Mielke, Westphal, Vanderkin, and Matoushek. No members are absent.

Management Staff present is Attorney VandeZande, Clerk Hull, Library Director Jaeger, Utility General Manager Posthuma, Finance Director Oosterhouse, Police Chief Louden, Public Works Director Daane, and Recreation Director Kaminski. Staff absent and excused is Administrator Schlieve and Fire Chief Demaa.

With no questions or concerns, the Council approves the consent agenda.

Motion Matoushek, second Vanderkin to approve the \$2500 Grand Slam donation level to the American Legion Gretchel-Nelson Post 210 for the Central Plains Regional National Tournament scheduled August 8-11, 2019 in Waupun, WI. Motion carried 4-2 on roll call with Kaczmarski and Westphal voting nay.

Alderman Vanderkin informs the Board that there will be a fundraiser at Tony's Pizza, on May 8, 2019, to raise funds for the 9-11 Never Forget Memorial Mobile Exhibit that the Waupun Festival is hosting during Celebrate Waupun 2019. Mayor Nickel comments that Jimmy Johns will also be holding a fund raiser for the 9-11 Memorial.
