AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF WEST MONROE, LOUISIANA TO SELL CERTAIN DESCRIBED IMMOVABLE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 309 MCCLENDON STREET WHICH IS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY PUBLIC PURPOSE BY THE CITY OF WEST MONROE, LOUISIANA TO MARK ALLEN TERRAL, AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.

WHEREAS, the City of West Monroe, Louisiana, owns certain immovable property located at 309 McClendon Street, West Monroe, Louisiana, which is not needed for public purposes, and

WHEREAS, the price offered, and the terms and conditions provided for the purchase of that property is fair and reasonable, and the sale and development of that immovable property would be beneficial to the City of West Monroe and its residents.

NOW, THEREFOR,

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana, in regular and legal session convened, that the City of West Monroe, Louisiana is hereby authorized to sell certain immovable property, i.e., that property located at 309 McClendon Street, West Monroe, Louisiana, which is not needed for any public purpose by the City of West Monroe, Louisiana, and which property is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

AN ORDINANCE TO ENLARGE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WEST MONROE, LOUISIANA PURSUANT TO R. S. 33:171 ET SEQ., BY ANNEXING TERRITORY CONSISTING OF A TRACT LOCATED AT 4331 CYPRESS STREET, AND WHICH PROPERTY IS OWNED BY BOBBY W. TINSLEY, AND AN ABUTTING TRACT LOCATED AT 4377 CYPRESS STREET, AND WHICH PROPERTY IS OWNED BY DUPRIEST INVESTMENTS, LLC, AND APPROXIMATELY 455 FEET OF US HIGHWAY 80, WHICH IS OWNED BY THE STATE OF LOUISIANA, **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT**, ALL OF WHICH SAID TERRITORY BEING CONTIGUOUS TO THE EXISTING BOUNDARIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY; TO RETAIN ANY LAWS OR ORDINANCES NOT REPUGNANT HERETO AND NOT SPECIFICALLY REPEALED HEREIN; AND TO PROVIDE THAT IF ANY SUB-SECTION, ARTICLE, CLAUSE, SENTENCE, PHRASE, OR PART, OR APPLICATION OF ORDINANCE FOR ANY REASON SHOULD BE FOUND UNCONSTITUTIONAL OR INVALID, NO OTHER PARTS AND/OR APPLICATIONS THEREOF SHALL BE AFFECTED.

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 33, Section 171 et seq., as amended, provides for the procedure for annexation of territory into the corporate limits of a municipality; and,

WHEREAS, by Ordinance Number 1646, adopted June 14, 1977, now codified in Sec. 1-2002 and 1-2003 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana, adopted by reference the provisions of R.S. 33:171 et seq., as amended from time to time by the Louisiana Legislature, in addition to vesting certain authority pertaining thereto in the Planning Commission of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana; and,

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 33:180 provides for annexation of public property and roads by ordinance, upon petition of the public body owning the land to be included, the municipality may upon majority vote adopt such an ordinance without the necessity of advertisement, petition by residents, or public hearing; and

WHEREAS, there has been compliance with the procedure required by R.S. 33:171 et seq., as amended, and R.S. 33:180, and Ordinance Number 1646 of the City of West Monroe, including but not limited to the following:

a) Petitions have been presented to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana by Bobby W. Tinsley requesting that property owned by petitioner and located at 4331 Cypress Street, West Monroe, Louisiana, (see Exhibit "1") and by Dupriest Investments, LLC requesting that property owned by petitioner and located at 4377 Cypress Street, West Monroe, Louisiana, (see Exhibit "2") be annexed into the corporate limits of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana. Said properties being contiguous to the

existing boundaries of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana and consisting of acreage more particularly shown by vicinity map attached hereto as **Exhibit "4"** and more particularly described in **Exhibit "5"**; and,

- b) The State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development has provided a Letter of no objection to the annexation of an approximate 455-foot linear segment of the full width of US Highway 80 (also known as Cypress Street)(see Exhibit "3"). Said segment of US Highway 80 being contiguous along its Southerly right-of-way line to the boundaries of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana upon the concurrent annexation of the petitioners' properties herein, and consisting of acreage more particularly shown by vicinity map attached hereto as **Exhibit "4"** and more particularly described in **Exhibit "5"**; and,
- A certificate of the Ouachita Parish Assessor is attached hereto as **Exhibit "6"** certifying that according to assessment for property taxes for 2023 for the property described in **Exhibit "5"** and depicted in **Exhibit "4"** that the property is owned by both a majority of the number of property owners and the owners of more than 25 percent in value of the property, with the petitioners representing the only private property to be annexed; and,
- d) A certificate of the Ouachita Parish Registrar of Voters is attached hereto as **Exhibit "7"** certifying that according to the records of the Registrar of Voters there are no registered voters residing within the territory described in **Exhibit "5"**; and,
- e) Proof of publication of the filing of the petition, as required by La. R.S. 33:172B, and of a public hearing by the West Monroe Planning Commission concerning the described annexation is attached hereto as **Exhibit "8"**; and,
- f) Pursuant to notice as evidenced by **Exhibit "8"**, the West Monroe Planning Commission on January 23, 2024 held a public hearing regarding said petitions for annexation, resulting in the recommendation to the West Monroe Board of Aldermen that the property described in **Exhibit "5"** be annexed into the corporate limits of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana; and,
- g) Pursuant to notice required by law, as evidenced by **Exhibit "9"**, the West Monroe Board of Aldermen on February 6, 2024, held a public hearing regarding said petitions for annexation.

WHEREAS, following the hearing by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen and after careful consideration of all recommendations, comments, and objects made at said hearing the Mayor and West Monroe Board of Aldermen declare that it is in the best interest of the City of West Monroe to annex into the corporate limits of the City of West Monroe the property described in Exhibit "5".

# NOW THEREFORE,

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana, in regular and legal session convened, that said property, contiguous to the existing boundaries of the corporate limits and located in the vicinity as shown by the map attached hereto as Exhibit "4" and more particularly described in Exhibit "5" be annexed into the corporate limits of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana.

changed in order that the annexation of property set forth above be effected at the earliest possible

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana, in regular and legal session convened, that all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith hereby are repealed, but this repeal shall be only insofar as such Ordinances conflict and/or are inconsistent with this Ordinance; and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances not inconsistent herewith shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of West Monroe, Louisiana, in regular and legal session convened, that the articles, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinances are deemed to be severable, and if any sub-section, article, clause, sentence, phrase, or part of this Ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional and/or invalid, such unconstitutionality and/or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining articles, sentences, paragraphs, clauses or phrases which can be given effect without the unconstitutional and/or invalid provision(s).





WHEREAS, the EMTs and paramedics of the West Monroe Fire Department have wished to expand their capabilities for a number of years, but have been unable to do so without access to more advanced equipment than previously available: and

WHEREAS, Pafford Emergency Medical Services, Inc wishes to donate a previously utilized item of equipment, with accessories and new batteries, that will allow expansion of the desired capabilities of West Monroe Fire Department, as explained by Fire Chief Charlie Simmons:

We are very excited to begin utilizing the capabilities of the LifePak 12 monitor/defibrillator. Although it is a previously utilized unit, it will still significantly improve the EMS capabilities of our department.

It has five main operating modes. Our EMTs can utilize the AED mode for prompt treatment of cardiac arrest victims, and our Paramedics can use the Manual mode for performing manual defibrillation, synchronized cardioversion, noninvasive pacing, and ECG monitoring.

An Inservice mode will also provide built-in training scenarios, which our paramedics can use to strengthen their cardiac treatment skills. It provides 4-lead and 12-lead ECG capabilities and 12-lead ECG with STEMI statements, which is 95.5% to 95.8% accurate in diagnosing STEMI (Myocardial Ischemia with ST Elevation - i.e., a heart attack), and diagnosing exactly where the blockage is occurring.

The monitor gives our department the ability to use end tidal CO2(ETCO2) monitoring of patients in respiratory distress/failure including those suffering from carbon monoxide poisoning (including firefighters, who are at significant risk while working at any fire scene).

This monitor also allows EMTs and Paramedics to carry one piece of equipment that will record oxygen saturation (SpO2), blood pressure (BP), ETCO2, and ECG simultaneously, and print a "code summary" with all the information gathered - allowing patient care reports to be completed more fully and accurately than before.

This piece of equipment is one that our department has wanted for to utilize for many years, but the cost has been beyond the Fire Department's budget. With the new batteries provided by Pafford Emergency Medical Services, proper care, and daily service tests, we expect that this monitor will provide our department with the expanded capabilities mentioned for the foreseeable future.
