City Council Meeting Staff Report

SUBJECT: Consideration and Adoption of Resolution Authorizing the Purchase of a Replacement Police Department Vehicle from Folsom Lake Ford

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Wheatland City Council consider adoption of a resolution authorizing the purchase of a replacement vehicle from Folsom Lake Ford for use by the Police Department sworn staff.

DISCUSSION:

The City’s Police Department sworn staff utilize City vehicles on a daily basis to complete their assigned tasks. During the development of the Fiscal Year 2024-25 budget, a Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund was established to accumulate funds for the orderly replacement of the City’s aging vehicle fleet and equipment inventory. The Fiscal Year 2025-26 adopted budget includes \$82,000 in the Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund for the replacement of a 2015 Ford Interceptor with 145,000 miles on the odometer that has exceeded its useful life. The replaced vehicle will be sold at public auction with any funds received deposited to the Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund.

The recommended purchase is a 2026 Ford Interceptor which will be assigned for Police patrol use. This vehicle is being purchased from Folsom Lake Ford under a government fleet purchase contract. The total purchase price is \$56,825.69.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this purchase is available in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund budget

WHEREAS, the City of Wheatland’s Police Department staff require the use of City vehicles to perform their daily assigned tasks; and

WHEREAS, the current vehicle fleet utilized by Police Department staff includes a vehicle that has exceeded its useful life; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2025-26 adopted budget includes funding for the replacement of one vehicle for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City received a quotation for the purchase of a 2026 Ford Intrceptor vehicle from Folsom Lake Ford under the provisions of a cooperative government purchase agreement; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price of this vehicle is \$56,825.69, which is within the funding amount approved in the current budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wheatland as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the necessary documents for the purchase of a 2026 Ford Interceptor from Folsom Lake Ford in an amount not to exceed \$56,825.69.
