The Parks and Recreation Committee is requesting Township Board approval to apply for a one-day liquor license to sell beer and wine at an event scheduled for Saturday, July 20, 2024 at Fisk Farm. The license type is a "Special License for Consumption on the Premises" which is issued by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC), under authority from the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA). A certified copy of a resolution of the Township Board authorizing the license request must be included in the application to the State.

For municipalities, the fee for the "Special License" is \$50. The license is valid for one day, with sales restricted from 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 a.m. The event will run from approximately 5:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. The Parks and Recreation Committee is prepared to provide a secure site with appropriate barriers as required by law and monitor and restrict beer/wine sales from visibly intoxicated persons and minors.
