#### WHITE LAKE TOWNSHIP PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE Regular Meeting

#### Hawley Park - 7525 Highland Road, White Lake, MI 48383 July 14, 2021 @ 7:00 p.m.

Ms. Carlock called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll was called.

- ROLL CALL: Merrie Carlock, Chairperson Rhonda Grubb, Planning Commission Liaison Deb Deren, Vice Chair Andrea Voorheis, Township Board Liaison
- Absent: Kathleen Aseltyne
- Also Present: Justin Quagliata, Staff Planner Sherri Barber, Recording Secretary

#### **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Member Deren moved to approve the agenda as presented. Member Voorheis supported and the MOTION CARRIED with a voice vote, 4 yes votes.

#### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Member Grubb moved to approve the minutes of June 9, 2021 as presented. Member Deren supported and the MOTION CARRIED with a voice vote, 4 yes votes.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Mrs. Earley (5925 Pine Ridge Ct.) was in attendance. She noted Hidden Pines needed a new park rules sign and some other updates. Staff Planner Quagliata stated the sign was ordered but not yet installed. Mrs. Earley appreciated all the work the Committee does. Member Carlock noted maybe there would be grant money available in the future for work on some of the parks.

Item A.

Steve Woodard (953 Schuyler) said Stanley Park was looking great. It had been seeded and the beach had been cleaned up. Staff Planner Quagliata thanked Mr. Woodard for volunteering with the park cleanup.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

a. Dog Park Resolution

The Committee spent some time researching and discussing dog parks. Staff Planner Quagliata presented a resolution formalizing the Committee's position on the matter.

Member Deren moved to adopt the Dog Park Resolution. Member Grubb supported and the MOTION CARRIED with a roll call vote: Carlock – yes; Grubb – yes; Deren – yes; Voorheis – yes. 4 yes votes.

#### b. <u>Hawley Park Site Walk</u>

The Committee walked the trail around the park. Some notes from the walk:

- Round-Up would be sprayed in the parking lot and volleyball court to cut down on weeds.
- New volleyball sand next year. Member Carlock asked for nice sand for the courts.
- The soccer goals were painted last summer. The nets would be put up next month. St. Pat's rented the soccer fields.
- The container in the park would eventually be removed.
- The trees were trimmed along the path.
- One lap around the path was 4/10 of a mile.
- The well was repaired for irrigation of the fields.
- The basketball court had new nets and one new goal.
- Member Carlock suggested staff check on the fall zone for the swing set and add chip trails through the grass to each amenity.

Staff Planner Quagliata thanked Township maintenance staff John Wheaton for his hard work in the parks. He added Mr. Wheaton often worked on the parks on his own time.

#### **OTHER BUSINESS:**

#### Resolution of Appreciation for CJ Bratta

Staff Planner Quagliata presented a resolution recognizing CJ Bratta's time with the Parks and Recreation Committee. Member Carlock suggested printing the resolution on nice paper and mailing it to Mr. Bratta.

Member Voorheis moved to adopt the resolution of appreciation for CJ Bratta. Member Deren supported and the MOTION CARRIED with a roll call vote: Carlock – yes; Grubb – yes; Deren – yes; Voorheis – yes. 4 yes votes.

#### **COMMUNICATIONS:**

#### a. <u>Member Comments</u>

Staff Report: Staff Planner Quagliata stated the Stanley Park picnic tables were delayed. He said the Township wanted to begin the amphitheater planning for Stanley Park. The amphitheater would not be covered by a grant. Member Carlock did not want to cut down trees without a plan. Member Voorheis asked if private donations from residents or businesses were solicited for funding. Staff Planner Quagliata said no.

Member Grubb noted the Planning Commission had met twice since the Committee last met. The Commission recommended preliminary site plan approval for the Pontiac Lake Apartments to the Township Board, contingent on Zoning Board of Appeals approval, which the applicant received with a lot of landscaping conditions. They do have to install curb and gutter around the parking area. The applicants for the Elizabeth Lake Retail project met with the Planning Commission and the Commission was not pleased with their plans. The Planning Commission had a subcommittee meeting with the applicants to discuss what they were looking for.

Member Carlock reported Harvest Happenings would be at Hess Hathaway this fall. Hess Hathaway now had two Dwarf Dexters and 10 turkey chicks.

Member Deren reported the run planned for August 7<sup>th</sup> was coming along nicely. It would start at Hawley Park.

Member Voorheis reported the Township Board had been busy and was still meeting via Zoom. October 16<sup>th</sup> was the Fisk Farm Halloween event. Staff Planner Quagliata told the Committee he let Greg Baroni know the Township would partner with the Historical Society on the event. Fisk Farm Festival was planned for the weekend after Labor Day.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.

The next meeting is Wednesday, August 11, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.



#### Stanley Park 2021 Survey (White Lake Township)

On June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Oakland County CISMA staff surveyed the Stanley Park property for invasive species. CISMA priority invasive species observed included *Phragmites* and Japanese Knotweed. Other invasive species observed included autumn olive, common buckthorn, glossy buckthorn, crown vetch, dame's rocket, garlic mustard, invasive honeysuckles, multiflora rose, bittersweet, reed canary grass, and spotted knapweed. See the map at the end of the document.

We recommend that the priority species be treated first, as they can have a large environmental and financial impact and can easily spread throughout the park.

A few small patches of *Phragmites* were observed throughout the park (represented by green dots) as well as some larger patches were observed (indicated by green polygons). Small patches can easily be treated by a few personnel (including possibly Oakland County CISMA as part of a fall work day event), but for larger patches we recommend hiring a contractor to treat. White Lake Township is eligible to use the current Oakland County invasive species contracts. For terrestrial species, these contracts are with Cardno and GEI. Email Erica for details on how to use the county contracts. This species can be easily identified by its height (up to 15 ft tall), silverygreen leaves, and feathery seed heads at the top of the plant.



Japanese knotweed was present in one small spot within the park (indicated by an orange dot). Knotweed can be identified up close by their zig-zagging, bamboo looking stems and spade-shaped leaves. Growing to about 8 feet tall, knotweed typically grows densely together and seems to overlap each other. Knotweed is easily spread as it can grow from broken fragments of the plant, as well as through seeds.







Both of these species will need multiple years of treatment for eradication of the species from the area. However, once patches get smaller, they can be treated by a small number of staff instead of contractors and will be cheaper.

We also recommend forestry mowing for large, dense sections of woody invasive species on the west side of the park (indicated by brown polygons) such as buckthorns and autumn olives. Oakland County CISMA staff would be able to control the few woody invasive shrubs along the main trail as part of a fall work day event, if you would like.

For the small invasives that can be hand-pulled, such as garlic mustard and dame's rocket, a public work day can be planned where volunteers will come out and spend the day pulling all of the plants and removing them from the site. This will be an especially efficient method for removing these species from the property because of their small presence here. However, this will need to be done for multiple years until they are completely eradicated from the site.

#### **Invasive Species ID Guide**

#### **Priority Species:**

#### **Phragmites**

*Phragmites (Phragmites australis subsp. australis)* are reeds that can grow up to 15 feet tall and in thick patches. They have a feather-like-top and leaves that attach to the stem in an alternating pattern. Their leaves are a blueish green or silver green color.

#### Japanese Knotweed

Japanese Knotweed (*Fallopia japonica*) is a perennial shrub native to east Asia. It grows to about 8 ft tall and is often seen growing in dense patches. The two best identifiers for japanese knotweed are its bamboo-looking stems and spade-shaped leaves. Lookalikes include other invasive knotweeds and native cottonwood saplings.



#### Autumn Olive

Restricted species in Michigan-do not sell or transport. A large shrub with leaves that are green with a distinctive silver underside with whole leaf edges that are wavy.

#### Buckthorn (Common & Glossy)

Purple to black fruits appear in the fall. Dark green, oval leaves that are slightly toothed in the Common variety, and leaves are smooth-edged and glossy with the Glossy variety. Twigs often have a sharp thorn at their intersect (Common).

#### Crown Vetch

A perennial legume that forms large monocultures with long (up to 6ft), creeping stems. It has compound leaves that consist of 15-25 pairs of oblong leaflets. Pink flowers are clustered in umbels on long stalks and form narrow, flattened seed-pods.

#### Dame's Rocket

An herbaceous, biennial plant that has alternate, toothed leaves. Leaves are also narrowly pointed and become smaller as they reach the top of the stems. Flowers are at the top of the stems and are regular with 4 petals. The flowers may be purple, pink, or white and arranged in clusters. Fruits are long cylindrical pods produced by each flower.

#### Garlic Mustard

Garlic mustard (*Alliaria petiolata*) is an herbaceous weed-like plant that primarily inhabits forested areas. New sprouts have heart shaped basal leaves the first year. As they mature, the leaves become triangular and toothed. The plants have small four-petaled flowers in spring. Plants can grow upwards and outwards up to four feet. When the plant is crushed or picked, you can smell a garlic-like odor.

Invasive Honeysuckles

Invasive honeysuckles include: Bell's, Amur (pictured), Morrow's, & Tartarian. Leaf shape can vary among different species. Second-year stems are hollow on the inside and berries are bright red.

#### Multiflora Rose

Stems are green to red with very large downward curving thorns. Smaller stems branch off of the main stem in an alternating pattern and each smaller stem has opposite leaves. Has five-petaled white to pink flowers.

#### **Oriental/Asian Bittersweet**

Bittersweet (*Celastrus orbiculatus*) is a woody, perennial vine that can climb up to 60 feet using surrounding plants or structures. Leaves alternate on each side of the vine and are oval in

shape. The fruits are yellow-orange berries that emerge from an outer shell and can persist over winter. The vines often climb on shrubs or strangle trees by coiling tightly around their trunk.

#### Reed Canary Grass

A large grass (2-9 ft tall) that has a hairless stem and tapering leaf blades. The leaf blades are flat and have a rough texture on both sides. Where the leaf blades meet the leaf sheath, there is a distinct, hairless membrane. Single flowers form in dense clusters that are green to purple and change to beige. This grass slightly resembles, but tends to be shorter, with different seed heads and a hairless membrane, whereas with *Phragmites*, the membrane has hairs.

#### Spotted Knapweed

An herbaceous, biennial plant that forms a basal rosette of leaves in the first year, then sends

up flowering stalks in the following years. Stalks formed in later years have alternate leaves that are un-toothed and have lobes. Flowers are compound (composed of numerous tiny flowers) and can be purple, pink, or white. Leafy bracts at the base of flowerheads turn brown and persist over winter. These plants can form dense monocultures.

RE: Field & Pavilion Rental Rate Recommendation

Staff is recommending the Parks and Recreation Committee recommend to the Township Board an amendment to the fee ordinance to increase the fees associated with the rental of Township fields and pavilions. The maintenance costs for facilities vastly exceed the current fees collected. The proposed fees would not cover the cost of maintaining the facilities, but would bring the fees to a more appropriate level. Comparatively, White Lake's rental fees are far below a number of other communities in Oakland County providing similar facilities.

The proposed rental rate for pavilions is \$80/block for Township residents and \$160/block for non-residents. Two blocks of time per day are proposed: 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. **or** 4:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. (dusk). Currently, the fee is \$60, or \$75 with electrical service (if service is available). For electrical service, the proposed fee is \$20. Overall, for residents this is a \$5 increase in fee for electrical service and \$20 increase in fee for the pavilions.

The proposed soccer field rental fees (per 2-hour block of time) are as follows:

- Field Practices/Games Large Field 3: \$100 (proposed \$50 increase)
- Field Practices/Games Small Field 1 & 2: \$90 (proposed \$50 increase)
- Field Practices/Games Quarter Practice Field: \$75 (proposed \$50 increase)

The soccer fields are costly to maintain (mowing, grass watering, trash removal, etc.). Of the proposed rate increases, staff recommends these rates be increased to no less than proposed.

The proposed rental rate for baseball/softball field practices and games (per 2-hour block of time) is \$95. Currently the fee is \$40.

The proposed rates for the basketball court and volleyball court are \$50 (per season). Currently these rates are \$25. These rates are currently listed as \$50 in the park policy documents; however, the \$25 rate is reflected in the fee ordinance.

The Hawley Park horseshoe pits were removed years ago and there is no intention to reinstall the pits. This rental rate should be removed from the fee ordinance. Unfortunately, the horseshoes were thrown around in a manner dangerous to people and property in the vicinity.

For reference, West Bloomfield has five shelters available for rent. Following are their 2021 rental rates (two shelters utilize the first rate structure listed below and three shelters utilize the second rate structure listed below):

- \$150/day resident rate; \$175/day non-resident rate
- \$200/day resident rate; \$250/day non-resident rate

#### <u>Waterford</u>

#### Hess-Hathaway

Picnic Pavilion 1 – seats 160 people, 20 picnic tables

\$220/day resident rate; \$250/day non-resident rate
 \$50 refundable damage deposit

Picnic Pavilion 2 - seats 88 people, 11 picnic tables

- \$150/day resident rate; \$180/day non-resident rate
  - \$50 refundable damage deposit

Drayton Plains Nature Center – pavilion seats up to 50 people

- \$125/day resident rate; \$155/day non-resident
  - \$50 refundable damage deposit

In Waterford, only game rentals are allowed on the soccer fields; there are no practice rentals. Their fees compared to the proposed White Lake fees are as follows:

- Large Field: \$80 resident rate; \$95 non-resident rate
- Small Field: \$70 resident rate; \$85 non-resident rate
- Quarter Practice Field: \$55 resident rate; \$65 non-resident rate

Based on neighboring communities' rental rates and the significant cost borne by the Township for park facilities, the proposed fees are appropriate and staff recommends the Committee forward the proposal to the Township Board. If a motion to modify the rental rates succeeds, the recommendation will be sent to the Township Board at the time of other fee ordinance amendments. Staff suggests the proposed rental rates take effect in 2022. The following motion has been provided for the Committee's consideration:

• Move to recommend approval of the field and pavilion rental rate increase as outlined in the memorandum dated October 13, 2021 to the Township Board for a fee ordinance amendment.

#### WHITE LAKE TOWNSHIP PARKS & RECREATION FACILITIES

The following policies and procedures relate to the publics' use of the recreational facilities which White Lake Township has developed. The rules and regulations set forth requirements relating to reservations for use of the facilities. The Township Board reserves the right to modify these rules and regulations at any time.

#### GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL TOWNSHIP PARKS

- 1. Parks are open from Dawn to Dusk throughout the year, weather permitting.
- 2. Alcoholic Beverages are prohibited in the Parks.
- 3. Parks users are responsible for any property that they carry into the Park.
- 4. During the duration of the activity, the user must provide supervision for all youths (under 18 years old) in attendance.
- 5. The running/walking track in Vetter and Hawley Parks are for walking, jogging, or roller blading.
- 6. Place all trash in the trash receptacles only.
- 7. Bottles, containers or other items made of glass are prohibited.
- 8. Dogs and other pets must be on a leash and under control of the owner.
- 9. No solicitation, vending, advertising or sign posting is allowed in the parks, except by permission of the Township.
- 10. No model airplanes are allowed in the parks.
- 11. All fireworks are prohibited in the parks.
- 12. No hunting allowed in the Township Parks.
- 13. Please report all emergencies or accidents by calling 911.
- 14. All park facilities used for organized /planned events require a permit obtained from White Lake Township.
- 15. No horses in Township Parks except on dedicated equestrian trails.
