# Innovation Center Lease Update

- 90% occupancy, 10% vacancy (approx.)
- Vacant suites:
  - 115, 122, 203, 223
- Had received inquiry from one potential tenant in September, but lease was not finalized
  - They went with another option
- Have one current tenant possibly taking over Room 203 (lease negotiation in process)
- US Forest Service leaving when lease runs out Dec. '25
  - Suite 216
  - Gave notice, no longer need the space



# Innovation Center Rental Update

- Continued interest in rental of spaces of full/partial day use
- Rentals for community information sessions, attorney meetings, leadership conferences, non-profit chapter meetings, construction company meetings, counseling, etc.
- Generally charging \$25.00/hr for rentals



# Innovation Center Miscellaneous Work

- New cleaning services began
  - Third-party vendor through Parks & Rec
  - Only received one minor complaint re: back stairwell
- New A/V system was installed in October
  - CDA covered this expense
  - More "plug & play" than the original system
- Updating tenant records
- Staffing changes
- Ongoing evaluation of space usage and future opportunities



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
