Explanation of Issue

The City of White Salmon is required to develop a balanced budget for the upcoming year. There are several required public hearings related to the budget including a budget hearing on proposed revenues. The attached budget summary provides history for 2020, 2021 and 2022 and identifies the revenues and expenditures currently proposed for 2023.

The preliminary budget is based on a minimum base budget with only known carryover projects being funded at this time. The Mayor has not made any decisions on budget options at this time. That information will be made available prior to the November 16 council meeting at which the city will hold another public hearing on the budget with a final hearing scheduled for December 7. The city must adopt a 2023 budget by December 31, 2022.

Proposed revenues include a 1% increase to property taxes. Property tax revenue is split between the Current Expense Fund and the Street Fund (68% and 32% respectively). The 1% increase is the maximum amount allowed and equates to \$4,210.89. Klickitat County also projects the city will receive an additional \$7,508.66 in revenue related to new construction and improvements to property. A presentation will be made at the November 2 meeting regarding property taxes and how the 1% affects levy rates. This is particularly important due to the increased assessed valuations property owners were recently notified about.

State law requires the city adopts both an ordinance and a resolution related to property taxes. The ordinance and resolution are attached. The City must file the ordinance and resolution with Klickitat County by November 30, 2022.

Proposed revenues also include a proposed 10% increase in water rates and a proposed 5% increase in wastewater rates. A public hearing and consideration of ordinances related to utility rates will be presented at the November 16 city council meeting.

- Staff and the Mayor will present a final budget to the City Council at the November 16, 2022 city council meeting.

ORDINANCE 2022-11-1114

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THE AMOUNT TO BE RAISED BY AD VALOREM TAXES TO BE LEVIED FOR THE YEAR 2023

WHEREAS, PURSUANT to the provisions of RCW 35A.33.135 and RCW 84.52.020, requiring the determination by the legislative body of the City of White Salmon to fix by Ordinance the amount to be raised by advalorem taxes to be levied, and the further requisite that the same shall be certified to the board of County Commissioners; now therefore:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Based upon the highest lawful levy amount of \$421,088.92 for the year 2022 as allowed by law, the specific sum to be raised by ad valorem taxes to be levied for 2023 thereby is the sum of \$432,808.47 including estimated new construction, improvements, annexations, any increases in the value of state assessed property and refunds made.

The Clerk Treasurer of the City of White Salmon is hereby authorized and directed to certify same unto the Board of County Commissioners of Klickitat County, pursuant to the provisions of and required by RCW 84.52.020, and a copy of this Ordinance shall be provided by the said Clerk Treasurer of the City of White Salmon unto the County Assessor of Klickitat County, Washington on or before November 30, 2021.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, and effective five (5) days after the first date of publication.
