JUNE 27: City Council Budget Workshop (Council Meeting)

JULY 7: FILE PROPOSED BUDGET WITH CITY SECRETARY

The proposed budget must contain a special cover page if the budget will raise more total property taxes than the previous year. The City Secretary must post the proposed budget on the City's website. Additionally, the proposed budget must include a line item comparing expenditures in the proposed budget and actual expenditures in the preceding year for: (1) notices required to be published in the newspaper; and (2) directly or indirectly influencing or attempting to influence the outcome of legislation or administrative action, as those terms are defined in Gov't Code Section 305.002 (See Tex. Loc. Gov't Code Section 140.0045).

JULY 25: CAD DEADLINE TO PROVIDED CERTIFIED APPRAISAL TAX ROLL

AUGUST 8: DISCUSSION OF TAX RATE; COUNCIL HOLDS A RECORD VOTE ON APPROVING PROPOSED TAX RATE; SET DATE TO CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING ON BUDGET AND TAX RATE FOR AUGUST

AUGUST 11: PUBLISH NOTICE OF BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING IN COMMUNITY NEWS FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON AUGUST 11; PUBLISH NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX RATE IN THE COMMUNITY NEWS

The notice of budget public hearing may not be published earlier than the 30th day before the public hearing and not later than the 10th day before the budget hearing. The budget hearing notice must contain specific information about property tax increases per Tex. Loc. Gov't Code Section 102.0065(d).

Post notice of that the tax rate that will exceed the no-new-revenue rate continuously on the City's website and publish in newspaper. The notice must be posted continuously on the City's website for at least 7 days immediately before the public hearing on the proposed tax rate increase and the vote on the proposed tax rate. (Tax Code Section 26.065). The notice must contain the content

required in Tax Code Sections 26.06(b-1), (b-2), and (b-3). The notice of tax rate hearing if the proposed tax rate will exceed the no-new-revenue rate, must be published at least 5 days before the public hearing on the tax rate.

AUGUST 22: COUNCIL WILL CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING ON BUDGET; FOLLOWING THE PUBLIC HEARING THE CITY COUNCIL VOTES TO ADOPT BUDGET; COUNCIL WILL CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX RATE; FOLLOWING THE PUBLIC HEARING, COUNCIL VOTES TO ADOPT TAX RATE

The City Council must take a separate ratification vote to adopt any budget that will raise total property tax revenue. The budget must contain a special cover page in accordance with the requirements of LGC Section 102.007(d). The adopted budget, including the cover page, must be posted on the City's website, along with an appendix that sets out the tax rate calculation forms used by the designated officer or employee to calculate the City's no new revenue tax rate and the voter approval tax rate.

CONTRACT FOR FOOD, POOL AND HOTEL/MOTEL INSPECTIONS

This contract is made and entered into by Duane R. Barritt and the City of Willow Park in the county of Parker, the State of Texas. Herein called "City" and Duane R. Barritt herein called "Contractor" will provide food, pool and hotel/motel services for establishments permitted by City.

Witnessed

For and in consideration of the mutual and knowledge undertakings herein set forth the parties agree as follows:

1. Contractor agrees to conduct full routine inspection of food establishments, public and semipublic pools and hotel/motel permitted by the City a minimum of 2 times a calendar year, to do follow-up inspections of any establishment in the City to verify corrections of any critical violations in the health code not corrected at the time of the initial inspection, to investigate complaints referred to the City or by the State of Texas, Department of State Health Services, review construction blue prints provided by the City or the Food Establishment, provide a 2 hour emergency response and after hour response upon request by the City.

2. The City agrees to pay the Contractor the following rates:

Bi-annual inspections for pools, spas, food establishment and hotel/motel inspections - \$100.00 per inspection.

Follow up inspections of pools, spas, food establishments, hotels/motels - \$100.00 per inspection.

A follow-up will be performed if the establishment has a score of 30 demerits or higher, has temperature violations, food equipment not working, or in the professional opinion of the Contractor that the public health hazard exists.

Temporary Event food Inspection -	\$50.00
Emergency Response Inspection -	\$100.00
After Hour Inspection -	\$100.00
Immediate Response -	\$100.00
Complaint Inspection -	\$100.00
Plan Review -	\$100.00 per plan review
Onsite Plan Review -	\$150.00 per plan review
Opening Inspection Fee -	\$100.00 per inspection

3. It is understood that the Contractor in an independent contractor providing specialized services and this contract cannot be assigned to another Contractor. Contractor agrees to provide his own personal services and may not employ other to do the required inspections without written approval agreement with the City.

4. This contract is performed in Parker County.

5. The term of the contract is for one year beginning **June 14, 2023**, and expiring on the last day of **June 14, 2024**.

6. Either party may terminate this contract without cause upon ten days of written notice.

7. The City agrees to pay Contractor for his services within 30 days after receiving an invoice.

BACKGROUND:

As part of the City's continuing work on drainage projects throughout the city, staff prepared bid requests for Phase 2 of the Drainage Project. Per Derek Turner's letter (attached), staff is recommending that Council award the bid to JRM Construction. The bid tab sheets have been attached as well.

This is the breakdown of projects for the Phase 2 Drainage Contract:

- 1. Reclaiming the channel off of Crown Pointe
- 2. Ditch improvements along Stagecoach Trail
- 3. Culvert upsizing on El Chico Channel and at Surrey Lane
- 4. Reclaiming drainage channel beside EPCC at IH20 culvert crossing
- 5. Ditch improvements on Chuckwagon Trail at IH20
- 6. Reclaiming channel off of Castlemount and above Willow Park North
- 7. Ditch improvements on Vista Drive, Coronado Court, and Live Oak Road

RE: City of Willow Park, Texas – Phase 2 Drainage Improvements Award Recommendation Letter

Dear Mr. Grimes:

We have evaluated the bids for the above referenced project and enclosed a bid tabulation showing the breakdown of the bids. The base bids consisted of furnishing and installing approximately 98 LF of 12" HDPE culvert, 219 LF of 18" RCP culvert, 22 LF of 24" RCP culvert, grade approximately 23,520 SY of drainage ditch, apply erosion protection measures to any disturbed areas, and associated appurtenances. The additive alternate consisted of furnishing and installing a third 48" RCP Culvert to an existing two (2) barrel culvert, installing two (2) new 4'x8' box culverts and all associated appurtenances. The low bidder was JRM Construction with base bids totaling \$949,095.00 and an additive alternate bid of \$69,500.00 for a total bid amount of \$1,018,595.00.

We have found no reason to disqualify the low base bidder and recommend awarding the contract to JRM Construction for a total bid of **\$1,018,595.00**.
