4. Marketing Update

Brian Stevenson provided an update on a few projects going on around the City of Wilsonville.

- The Parks Maintenance team is currently on the search for a bike repair station to recommend to increase bike amenities for visitors.
- The Arts Culture Heritage Commission will be reviewing the designs of the three Boones Ferry Public Art Project finalists.
- There were two regional soccer tournaments hosted at Boones Ferry Park.
- In 2027, the American Contract Bridge League will be bringing their tournament to the Holiday Inn.
- The Fall Harvest Fest at Stein-Boozier Barn will take place on October 18.
- Staff answered questions regarding the boat launch and ADA river access at Boones Ferry Park.
