## Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee Staff Report

**Subject:** Little Free Library Art Review

**Recommended Action:**

Review the mural planned for the Little Free Library at Boones Ferry Park.

**Background and Process:**

The Library Foundation invited the Committee to support and steward the planned Little Free Library (LFL) at Boones Ferry Park near the inclusive playground. The committee enthusiastically supported the project and steward the program at their March 11, 2025 meeting. The stewardship agreement was completed in May 2025.

The LFL will be a larger version of the normal box and include books that focus on diversity. A plaque identifying the support of the DEI Committee is expected to be added to the LFL. Also, to make the LFL extra special, Kristi Park, volunteer and coordinator for Wilsonville's LFL program worked with Wilsonville High School Students to commission a mural for the exterior of the physical LFL box. Ms. Park is seeking the committee's feedback on the design to ensure that it is inclusive, and the committee does not see any potential errors or omissions.

**Next Steps:**

The committee will provide feedback and become the steward of this LFL upon its installation.

**Subject: Pride Pin Design Prompt**

### **Recommended Action:**

Create a prompt to inspire the design of the 2026 City of Wilsonville Pride Pin.

### **Recommended Motion:**

I move to provide the Pride Pin Prompt as (recommended / modified) to Wilsonville High School students to design the 2026 Pride Pin.

### **Background and Process:**

The Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) Committee created the City's first Pride Pin in 2024 provide visual representation to uplift, recognize and celebrate the LGBTQIA+ community and celebrate and honor Pride Month. The design was developed by city staff with direct input from the committee. In 2025, the committee directed staff to partner with Wilsonville High School National Art Honor Society. The city received six (6) designs and selected the 2025 pride pin designed by Junior (FY 25-26) Maleeya Rodenbeck.

At the February 10 committee meeting, the committee voted to engage Wilsonville High School to design the 2026 pin. City Staff confirmed with Angenette Escobar, Art Teacher, that WHS students would be able to design a new Pride Pin within the proposed timeline (see Next Steps).

### Pride Mural Prompt 2026:

"Designs may incorporate or be inspired by the Progress Pride Flag and its colors, but ultimately artists should use their own creativity when submitting a design that they feel is representative, celebratory and meaningful of the LGBTQIA+ community and Pride Month".

### Pride Pin Prompt 2025:

The original art will provide visual representation to uplift, recognize, and celebrate the LGBTQIA+ community. The art will be used on a lapel pin therefore intricate designs may be hard to see. The pin can be 1inch x 1 inch or 1.5 x 1.5 inch. The image (art) will be printed on the pin. The pin should include the City logo (in signature line below), or "City of Wilsonville", or "Wilsonville, Oregon"

### Draft Pride Pin Prompt 2026:

The original artwork may incorporate or be inspired by the Progress Pride Flag and its colors, but ultimately artists should use their own creativity when submitting a design that they feel is representative, celebratory and meaningful of the LGBTQIA+ community and Pride Month". The pin can

be 1inch x 1 inch or 1.5 x 1.5 inch. The image (art) will be printed on the pin. The pin should include the City logo, or “City of Wilsonville”, or “Wilsonville, Oregon”

**Next Steps:**

The DEI Committee must select a pride pin design prompt to inspire the 2026 pride pin. The expected timeline is as follows:

March 10: DEI Committee adopts guidelines and/or prompt for students.

March 12 – March 30: WHS Students prepare original art and submit to Art Teacher.

March 31 – April 3: High School Gay Straight Alliance (GSA) reviews art with the Art Teacher and selects top three (3) designs.

April 6 – 8: Art Teacher sends top three (3) designs to City Staff.

April 14: City Staff share the designs with DEI Committee at their meeting; DEI Committee selects their preferred design.

April 15 – 17: City Staff, confirms selected design with the Art Teacher, and provides contract to procure the rights to the design

April 20 – 24: Art Teacher works with the student artist to review the art agreement, provide student and parent/ guardian approval (if under 18), and return agreement to city staff by April 27.

April 27 – May 9: Art Teacher to work with student and guardian (if under 18) to provide a bio, picture if desired and authorize the city to share their bio and announce the students name by May 10.

May: City staff will have the design made into a pin.

June: Student artist recognized in the Boones Ferry Messenger and/or Pride Event (June 13).
