LIQUOR COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, June 10, 2026 at 5:30 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

PRESENT: Commissioner Franklin J Eubank, Jr., Adam LeFevre, Kelli Jeffers, and Jim O'Rourke.

GUESTS: Attorney Mary Gaziano, and Administrator Joey Dienberg, Deputy Clerk Symonds.

3. DISCLOSURE OF ANY CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Commissioner Eubank informed the members that he has performed legal council for Table Talk Supper Club in the past.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

No one was present to address the commission.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- a. Minutes from Month - March 11, 2026 - unavailable

6. DISCUSSION

- a. Table Talk Supper Club - Liquor Application

The application for Table Talk Supper Club was reviewed by the Village Attorney who noted minor corrections. Commissioner Eubank stated that the background report for Mr. Woolbright was received, and Mrs. Woolbright's is in process. Ms. Jeffers was in favor or making the recommendation for approval for the Class A license upon the receipt of the background check. Mr. LeFevre asked for a motion to recommend the Commissioner grant the Class A Liquor License to Table Talk Supper Club subject to

the successful background check. Ms. Jeffers made the motion, seconded by Mr. O'Rourke. No further discussion. Motion carried on a unanimous voice vote.

7. NEW BUSINESS

Commissioner Eubank brought up the subject of the requirement in the current Liquor Ordinance which requires a copy of the Title Policy for the property of a liquor establishment to be submitted with the New Retail Liquor Application. Commissioner Eubank stated that it is something that we should not require as it does take time to get a Title Policy and could delay licensing and questioned if a copy of the deed with the recorder's stamp would be sufficient. If the Title Policy is required by the State Liquor Control Commission than we should also require it, but if not we should consider amending our ordinance.

8. EXECUTIVE SESSION

9. ADJOURNMENT

The motion to adjourn was made by Mr. O'Rourke, second by Ms. Jeffers. Motion carried on a voice vote. Adjourned at 5:51 p.m.
