#### CITIZEN ENGAGEMENT

#### **REGULAR SESSION**

5. Consider and take appropriate action on report from staff regarding recent city-organized events.

Director of Development Services Tara Tomlinson and EDC Director Danielle Sweat gave updates on City events including 4th on the 5th, Harvest Festival and Christmas events. More event staff including citizen volunteers will be needed to continue to host these events. City Staff along with overtime Police officers and Public Works employees are no longer adequate for these large events.

The formation of a committee of volunteers was discussed. The Mayor asked for a recruitment of volunteers to be undertaken by staff with leadership and oversight of committee and events held by city employees. Volunteers could be utilized to plan and implement future city events. There is concern that volunteers would be hard to find and interns with programs at Texas Tech might be a better solution. Interns could also fundraise for events to possibly cover event cost including manpower.

Motion to purchase traffic cones not exceed \$7,000 using Hotel Occupancy Tax Funds as recommended by staff.

Committee met to discuss options for a logo for the new Alcove Elevated Storage Tank. The committee discussed several options, including new and old designs, and is recommending a simplistic design of the Wolfforth name. Councilmember Brashier voiced concerns over the cost of adding the logo to the tower. Council discussed at length the value of adding the logo and the identification of that logo for visitors to Wolfforth.
