BACKGROUND:

Staff is requesting approval to proceed with the required public hearing process related to the proposed expenditure of EDC funds for the purchase of an existing building located at 502 E Highway 62, currently occupied by the UMC clinic, for business retention purposes.

This purchase will allow a current, long-standing Wolfforth business the opportunity to remain within the city limits, supporting local jobs and continued economic activity in our community.

In accordance with state law, public comments will be accepted between February 11, 2026 and April 12, 2026. The City Council will hold a public hearing on March 2, 2026 at 6:00 PM, followed by a Wolfforth EDC public hearing on March 3, 2026 at 11:30 AM, both to be held in the Wolfforth City Hall Council Chambers.

The public hearing process provides transparency and gives community members the opportunity to share any comments or concerns prior to final action by the board. This project aligns with the EDC's mission to retain existing businesses and strengthen Wolfforth's economic base.

BACKGROUND:

Last year, the EDC sponsored two Frenship Foundation events: the Frenship Foundation Golf Tournament and *An Evening in Big Cat Country*.

For the Golf Tournament, the EDC participated at the \$4,000 sponsorship level, which includes two bays. Historically, we play in the afternoon and typically do not use both bays, choosing instead to donate one back to the Foundation. That said, it would be fun (and great visibility for the EDC) to fill both bays this year if possible. The 2026 Golf Tournament is scheduled for May 14.

An Evening in Big Cat Country will be held on October 15. Last year, the EDC purchased a table at the \$7,500 level. The event was a huge success, and organizers have shared that this year's event will be modeled closely after last year's format and experience.

Funds from both sponsorships directly support educator grants through the Frenship Foundation. We are able to specifically request that our sponsorship dollars be allocated to schools located within Wolfforth city limits. Additionally, if there is a Career and Technical Education (CTE) grant request tied to our sponsorship, the EDC has the opportunity to present that check in the fall as part of the Foundation's "prize patrol" days that come with sponsorship participation.

These sponsorships continue to support Frenship ISD while also providing meaningful community visibility, relationship-building opportunities, and a direct way for the EDC to invest back into Wolfforth classrooms.

BACKGROUND:

The Lubbock Chamber’s Community Prayer Luncheon is scheduled for May 7, 2026. Last year, the Wolfforth EDC participated in this event for the first time and chose to sponsor at the Platinum level. At that time, the intent was to ensure strong visibility as a new participant and to signal our support for this long-standing community event.
