A reimbursement resolution allows the City to pay bills as they are due and reimburse itself when the bond funds. Tax Exempt Bond Funds are hard to find.

Mr. Ryan Thomas explained that the contractor will decide the priority of the streets in the pre-bid meeting. K.Friese will evaluate every street in the City to determine the work that is needed to be performed and will provide details for each street in their plan submissions.

The Panel can also provide a Maintenance Plan for the streets for care after this project is completed.
