## Notes on Survey

- Q6 Although it asks "Which" someone may check more than one. We should either state "Choose One" or allow more than one with a grading scale:
- Q7 Change "their" to "the"
- Q9 Change "A. At your residence" to "A. At or in your house or yard or both" Perhaps making these two choices: House/Yard
- Q10 Add "either inside the residence or damage to the yard." At the end of the existing question
- Q12 The grading reference is vague; "Severe Damage to what: House, Yard, driveway?" A better choice of responses, such as "Severe or major Damage to House," "Had to replace Landscaping," etc.
- Q20 Remove the word "Sidewalk" as it evokes a specific image of a concrete walkway such as in the suburbs of more urban developments. "Pathway" or "Walkway" is a better term.
- Q21 As above, but this question and Q20 seem redundant. We would be better served by adding a question regarding recent traffic calming measures. With

- Q26 Somehow, we should mention costs associated with a Community Pool, which may be the prohibiting factor here as it would most likely require increase in taxes.
- Q30 Does the State differentiate ABOVE or BELOW ground?

- Q32 A Food Truck or an in-home venture may not be a "Development" but a new "Enterprise."
- Q33 Somehow, we should differentiate between Food Truck courts and a seasonal ice cream truck. Again, an "Enterprise" not a development
- Q39 Make it clear, we are referencing "Chickens"
- Q40 Please make it plain that we are referring to CURRENT staff or officers, not previous administrations
- Q45 Add an option, "Prefer not to respond"
- Q47 Change "Other" to "Prefer not to answer"
- Q52 This breaks anonymity as to questionnaire. They should merely be told how to send in their information separately from this questionnaire.
