#### **Event Overview**

Event Name: Woodcreek's 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Community Egg Hunt & Picnic Date & Time: Saturday, April 19, 2025, from 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM

Location: Augusta Park, Woodcreek, TX

Anticipated Attendance: 30-50 children + their families

#### **Event Description:**

The Woodcreek Community Relations Committee is excited to host a Community Egg Hunt & Picnic, bringing families together for a fun-filled morning. The event will feature an Easter egg hunt, an adult egg toss, a kids' obstacle course, face painting, and coffee & donuts. Children must be pre-registered by dropping off 10 eggs/child or bringing 10 eggs per child to participate in the hunt. Guests are encouraged to bring their own beverages (BYOB).

#### **Event Components & Activities**

- **Egg Hunt:** Participants must pre-register by dropping off 10 eggs/child or bring 10 eggs per child to the event to participate. The eggs will be hidden in designated age-group sections.
- **Kids Obstacle Course:** A small course set up with cones, hula hoops, and tunnels on the bocce ball court.
- Face Painter: A local artist providing face painting for children.
- Adult Egg Toss: A fun competition for adults.

- **BYOB:** Families are welcome to bring their own beverages for the picnic.
