The members of the City Boards, Commissions, Panels and/or Committees may participate in discussions on the items listed on this agenda, which occur at this meeting, but <u>no action</u> will be taken by those in attendance unless such action item is specifically listed on an agenda during a regular or special meeting for the respective Board, Commission, Panel and/or Committee subject to the Texas Open Meetings Act.

The City Council may retire to Executive Session any time during this meeting, under Texas Government Code, Subchapter D. Action, if any, will be taken in open session.

This agenda has been reviewed and approved by the City's legal counsel and the presence of any subject in any Executive Session portion of the agenda constitutes a written interpretation of Texas Government Code Chapter 551 by legal counsel for the governmental body and constitutes an opinion by the attorney that the items discussed therein may be legally discussed in the closed portion of the meeting considering available opinions of a court of record and opinions of the Texas Attorney General known to the attorney. This provision has been added to this agenda with the intent to meet all elements necessary to satisfy Texas Government Code Chapter 551.144(c) and the meeting is conducted by all participants in reliance on this opinion.

Any citizen shall have a reasonable opportunity to be heard at any and all meetings of the Governing Body in regard to: (1) any and all matters to be considered at any such meeting, or (2) any matter a citizen may wish to bring to the Governing Body's attention. No member of the Governing Body may discuss or comment on any citizen public comment, except to make: (1) a statement of specific, factual information given in response to the inquiry, or (2) a recitation of existing policy in response to the inquiry. Any deliberation of or decision about the subject of the inquiry shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a subsequent meeting per Texas Local Government code Sec.

Citizen comments will be allowed at the beginning of every meeting, or alternatively, before an item on the agenda upon which the citizen wishes to speak is to be considered. All citizens will be allowed to comment for **three (3) minutes** per person and shall be allowed more time at the Mayor or Chair's discretion. In addition, citizens may pool their allotted speaking time. To pool time, a speaker must present the names individuals present in the audience who wish to yield their three(3) minutes. Citizens may present materials regarding any agenda item to the City Secretary at or before a meeting, citizens attending any meeting are requested to complete a form providing their name, address, and agenda item/concern, but are not required to do so before speaking and presenting it to the City Secretary prior to the beginning of such meeting. Comments may only be disallowed and/or limited as per Government Code § 551.007(e).

#### **AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY:**

For 2023, Stonehouse Circle was identified and selected for special attention under the annual beautification project to address the Oak Wilt in the area. Due to the significant weather events of the year, it has been determined that identifying Oak Wilt at this juncture will be difficult and it is recommended that projects such as this be delayed until next Spring when the trees come out of the winter dormancy period. With that in mind, the City has an opportunity to redirect those funds and efforts to another area. The Triangle was recently selected as a spot for landscaping improvements through the application of the Quadratic "Energize the Environment" grant. The City could consider contributing additional funds now to an effort to create a pollinator and butterfly garden with drought tolerant landscaping and a drainage plan around the gazebo. This would prepare the area for planting in the Spring.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Recommend that Council postpone the Stonehouse project and take up The Triangle Gazebo Garden Project for the second annual City of Woodcreek beautification project of 2023.

# Triangle Greenspace Gazebo Garden

# The 2<sup>nd</sup> annual City of Woodcreek Beautification Project



<u>REQUEST:</u> Council approves a one-time expenditure of \$2,000 to create garden beds (fall of 2023) to surround the gazebo foundation for the installation of drought tolerant plants and a butterfly garden in the Spring of 2024.


### **DETAILS:**

- This effort will include a collaboration between the Community Garden members and Parks Board members in addition to other members of the community who wish to participate.
- Additional funding has been applied for a \$3,500 Quadratec Cares "Energize the Environment" Grant to install plants.
- If grant funds are not allotted, then donations will be sought for plantings.
- The garden beds will sit just below the concrete foundation of the gazebo surrounding it on all sides with a width of 4.5 feet out from the edge of the concrete.
- The beds will feature a natural rock edging, filled with dirt, and topped with mulch while they await planting in the spring.
- Around the direct base of the gazebo will be a French drain filled with river rock spanning 1.5ft out from the concrete pad.
- The grounds under the beds will be scraped from grass and debris before installation and a water permeable barrier will be installed to discourage weeds.
- All labor will be donated. Funding request is for materials alone. Any remainder will be returned to the City for use on other projects.

### **GOALS**:

- Further enhance the curb appeal of the gazebo
- Provide for pollinator and butterfly habitat
- Help prevent washout and erosion around the base of the gazebo by creating a natural catchment for water with the French drain and plants. The French drain will also serve to create a berm and swell effect to promote slowing the water down for improved water retention for the plants and groundwater recharging for the aquifer.
- Help reduce the likely hood and urge for younger residents to climb around the outside of the gazebo railing by creating a natural visual cue that this area is not meant for play.
- The area can also be used an educational opportunity for drought tolerant, native, and pollinator habitat plantings.
