Minutes of the Regular Wrangell Port Commission Meeting

Held February 4th, 2021

Chairman John Martin called the Regular Port Commission meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. February 7th, 2020, via Zoom

PRESENT: Martin, Yeager, Roppel, Merritt

ABSENT: Morrison

Harbormaster Steve Miller was also in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

a. Approval minutes from meeting January 7th, 2021

M/S: Merritt/Yeager to approve the minutes, as presented. Motion approved unanimously.

HARBORMASTER'S REPORT

Miller reported on the following items:

- Harbormaster has been working on FAA regulations for the sea plane base sponsorship. Myers Chuck has been removed from the National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems (NPIAS). Miller will reach out to Congressman Young about possibly reinstating Myers Chuck.
- Harbormaster Miller is attending National Association of Counties High Performance Leadership Course. This is a 12-week course that focuses on positive leader. Miller has just completed his first 4 weeks.
- Harbor Maintenance Team is working on the new summer float with cutting and prepping lumber. The maintenance team also completed monthly fire extinguisher checks.
- Port security plan is done and waiting to be approved by the US Coast Guard.
- Harbormaster is continuously talking with the cruise ship industry about the upcoming season. Still no information if the 2021 season will happen.

COMMISSIONER REPORTS

Merritt stated that he was very impressed with getting his boat hauled out with the Marine Service Center. Merritt gave "kudos" to the entire team. Martin expressed concern for snow removal in the yard and where the snow goes. Miller explained that the snow is placed at the edge of the Marine Service Center.

NEW BUSINESS

10a FY 2022 Budget Calendar

Budget prep documents were supposed to be released on Feb. 1st. Miller is still waiting for the Finance Dept to send out the proposed 2022 spreadsheets. Miller has until March 1st to get the FY 2022 rough draft budget done.

10b Derelict Vessels Monthly Rates

The Storage Yard is losing around \$1,564.36 a month in derelict vessels taking up space and the Harbor is losing \$573.08 a month. Miller only has \$5,000 for the yard and \$5,000 for the Harbor in the budget for vessel disposal. Miller needs more money in the budget to remove all the impounded vessels taking up space. Miller wants to invest in an open top container to put disposed vessels in. The Harbor Office will start the impound process on vessels at 90 days so account balances don't grow out of control.


HARBORMASTER'S REPORT MARCH 2021

Administration- We have been working on the live-aboard language and gathering information from other Harbors to present to the Port commission and Assembly. We have been also working on budget since the middle of February and will have something for the Port Commission to look at by the April meeting.

Harbor- On February 7th there was a waterline leak reported at Heritage harbor upon inspection we found a flange had completely corroded away and the line parted. The Harbor had spare parts and a diver was called in to make repairs. The diver did a little recon and found another flange that was also severely corroded. I had to do some research and found that all of phase one waterline at Heritage Harbor had been put together with flanges that had a manufacturing flaw. There is a total of 5 connections 10 flanges that need immediate repairs this is our potable water and first response fire line. The total cost for repairs is estimated at \$8000 which I had to request from the assembly because our maintenance budget could not absorb that amount of money.

Port- We will be doing an inspection of the barge ramp in March. There was a comprehensive study done about 10 years ago and it is in need of some major repairs. I am working with a couple of local contractors with special equipment to do some audio gage testing and check coatings and zincs on the air bladder. There will be a more comprehensive report for the April meeting.

MARINE SERVICE CENTER- There has been an uptick of vessels being hauled out in the marine service center. The spring haul out request's have been flooding in so I am very optimistic about the spring rush of boats coming to Wrangell for maintenance.

RECOMMENDATION MOTION (after Public Hearing is closed):

Move to Approve ORDINANCE No. 984

SUMMARY STATEMENT:

This ordinance change was needed in order to define who qualifies as a live aboard and to set clear rules as to who may be assed a residential user fee. The harbor for years has billed a live aboard fee and the language was not sufficient in current ordinance to charge such a fee.

This Ordinance change was sent back to the port commission with new wording because there were to many question about who this would and would not affect. Definition DD "Live Aboard" was not changed from the original proposed ordinance change. MM The "Residential user" is now defined as: When a vessel is used by any person as a residence, dwelling, or abode for 60 or more calendar days in a calendar year: This wording helped eliminate any vessel with persons living aboard for a short period of time. These user's pay up to 95% more than an annual stall holder. (IE Daily moorage for a 40" vessel is \$23.60 @ the daily rate. An annual 40' vessel pays \$3.19 a day @ the annual rate.)

In order to help facilitate this ordinance we also included 14.05.008 "Residential User Fee and Duty to report" The residential user fee will be assessed on a calendar month basis. The owner of the vessel is responsible for paying the residential user fee. The owner of the vessel is responsible for immediately notifying the Harbor Department Office when their vessel is being occupied and used, rented, or leased as a place of residence. Once a vessel is used as a residence, the Harbor Department will continue to assess the residence user fee until the owner of the vessel gives written notice to the Harbor Department that the vessel is no longer used for a residence. Residential Fees shall be adopted in the Harbor and Port Facilities Fee Schedule by Resolution of the Assembly.

The port and Harbor office will have a vessel registration form that will be filled out by all live aboard vessel owners. It will be the owner's responsibility to notify the Harbor Office when they no longer live aboard the vessel.

ORDINANCE NO. 984

AN ORDINANCE OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF WRANGELL, ALASKA, AMENDING SECTION 14.01.030(DD) TITLED "LIVE ABOARD" AND ADDING SECTION 14.01.030(MM) TITLED "RESIDENTIAL USER" AND ADDING 14.05.008 "RESIDETIAL USER FEE AND DUTY TO REPORT" IN THE WRANGELL MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, pursuant to WMC 14.11.005 the Assembly has authority to establish the fee schedule for Wrangell Port and Harbors; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to update the Wrangell Municipal Code (WMC) Title 14 to better define "Live Aboard" and define "Residential User Fee" of the Wrangell Ports and Harbors; and

WHEREAS, the current definition does not adequately support collection of the current Live Aboard Fee; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to charge for prolonged over-night use of moored vessels as living quarters because the use creates increased impacts on the Wrangell Ports and Harbors facilities, dockside utilities, the pumping stations and the harbor eco system; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to adequately and fairly collect fees for these additional burdens from those enjoying the use; and

WHEREAS it has become increasingly difficult to assess the fee under the current definition of Live Aboard codified in WMC 14.01.030(DD); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make these changes for efficient and equitable administration of the Wrangell Ports and Harbors; and

WHEREAS, these changes are of a permanent nature amending the code, an ordinance is appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF WRANGELL, ALASKA, that:

[The changes to the existing code are shown as follows: the words that are <u>underlined</u> are to be added and the words that are **[bolded and in brackets are to be deleted]**.]

- SEC. 1. <u>Action</u>. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Section 14.01.030(DD) of the Wrangell Municipal Code titled Live Aboard and add Section 14.01.030(MM) titled Residential User.
- SEC. 2. <u>Amendment of Section</u>. Section 14.01.030 (DD) of the Wrangell Municipal Code is amended to read:
 - DD. "Live aboard" means any vessel utilizing the harbor as a primary residence <u>for one or more persons</u>. Any vessel <u>using the harbor this way</u> **[thus used]** must still comply with **[all vessel]** <u>other vessel</u> requirements of the harbor system. <u>All Live Aboards shall be charged the Residential User Fee.</u>
- SEC 3. <u>Addition of Section</u>. Section 14.01.030 "Definitions" shall further be amended to include a new Subsection (MM) that shall read:
- MM. "Residential User" When a vessel is used by any person as a residence, dwelling, or abode for 60 or more calendar days in a calendar year and pays annual moorage.
- SEC. 4. <u>Amendment of Chapter:</u> Chapter 14.05 Moorage of the Wrangell Municipal Code is amended to add Section 14.05.008 titled "Residential User Fee Period and Duty to Report".
