Executive Summary

A Call for Artists has gone out to artists for submissions regarding the art project for the new Fire Station #4. The close of the call was April 26, 2021. The panel has ranked the 72 artist submissions in the order of preference. The scale was 1-7 with 7 being the most preferred. Other panel members could not see the ranking of others.

After taking out the artists scoring a 4.4 or lower, there were 24 artists left. The panel met on May 20, 2021 and chose the three semi-final artists. They are as follows: James Dinh, Matthew Duffy, and Terrance Martin, with Jeanine Centuori as the alternate.

The board may approve the three artist chosen or other artist that submitted applications. Action by the board is requested.
