CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Matthew Porter called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The following City Council members were present: Councilman David R. Duke, Councilman Dave Strang (6:49 p.m.), Mayor *pro tem* Jeff Forrester, Councilman Scott Williams, Councilman Sid Hoover, and Councilman Gino Mulliqi.

Mayor Porter convened the Council into break at 6:17 p.m.

Mayor Porter reconvened the Council into Regular Session at 6:19 p.m.

Tina Stelnicki, Wylie Chamber of Commerce CEO, addressed the Council thanking Council and staff for the assistance at the Wylie Championship Rodeo. Stelnicki presented each Council member with a challenge coin.

A motion was made by Mayor *pro tem* Forrester, seconded by Councilman Mulliqi, to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. A vote was taken and the motion passed 6-0 with Councilman Strang absent.

REGULAR AGENDA

1. Consider, and act upon, Ordinance No. 2023-47 of the City of Wylie, Texas, amending Wylie's Code of Ordinances, Ordinance No. 2021-17, as amended, Chapter 78 (Parks and Recreation), Article VIII (Planting, Maintaining Trees, Shrubs on Public Property), Section 78-256(b)(3)a. (Adjacent Landowner Responsibility); increasing the required clearance height of trees and shrubs that extend over the curb line; providing for repealing, savings and severability clauses; providing for an effective date of this ordinance; and providing for the publication of the caption hereof.

Staff Comments

Community Services Director Haskins addressed the Council stating the City Ordinance allows property owners to plant shrubs and trees along a street in an area that is adjacent to their property but in the public ROW. The Ordinance does require the property owner to maintain any trees or shrubs in that area. Staff is recommending an amendment to the Code of Ordinances to increase the clearance height from 13 feet to 15 feet to afford clearance of certain public service vehicles, such as utility and fire trucks.

Council Comments

Mayor *pro tem* Forrester stated he had concerns with raising the height and would like to ensure the trees are maintained at the height but not butchered. Haskins replied the City can encourage and add language in the letter that the trees are cut properly; however, the City cannot enforce that. Forrester asked if the City had to send an arborist out, would the City communicate with them to ensure it is trimmed properly. Haskins replied yes, the City would communicate that with the contractor. Councilman Mulliqi asked if the City would bill the property owner for any expenses incurred if the City has to have an arborist come out. Haskins replied yes, the City will. Councilman Williams stated he is in support of this change as 13 feet is not high enough.

Council Action

A motion was made by Councilman Williams, seconded by Councilman Duke, to approve Item 1 as presented. A vote was taken and the motion passed 6-0 with Councilman Strang absent.

2. Consider, and act upon, Ordinance No. 2023-48 releasing a portion of the City of Wylie's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction, consisting of a 0.697-acre tract of land located in the Hunters Glen Addition, Lot 1, Blk 1, located at 101 Hunters Glen Drive.

Staff Comments

Community Services Director Haskins addressed the Council stating during the 88th regular session of the Texas Legislature, Senate Bill 2038 created the ability for property owners to petition a municipality to be released from that municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ). The law requires the petitioner to supply certain information and the City Secretary to verify that information. Once the petition has been verified, the governing body must act on the petition, and as long as all requirements are met as outlined in Sec 42.104 of the Texas Local Government Code, approve the release as required by Sec 42.105. The City Secretary received a petition for the release of 101 Hunters Glen Drive in Dallas County.

Council Comments

Mayor Porter confirmed that with the change in the state law, as long as all of the requirements are met, this becomes a parliamentary procedure of the Council. Haskins confirmed that is correct and if the Council does not take action within 45 days of the petition being validated, then by law they are removed from the ETJ.

Council Action

A motion was made by Mayor *pro tem* Forrester, seconded by Councilman Duke, to approve Item 2 as presented. A vote was taken and the motion passed 6-0 with Councilman Strang absent.

3. Consider, and act upon, the award of bid #W2023-106-B for McMillen Road from McCreary Road to Country Club Road to McMahon Contracting L.P. in the estimated amount of \$21,265,684.73 and authorizing the City Manager to execute any necessary documents.

Staff Comments

Purchasing Manager Hayes addressed the Council stating staff published a competitive sealed bid for the road improvements and received seven bids. The low bid for construction for \$19,332,440.66 is from McMahon Contracting LP. The total award recommendation for the project is the low bid of \$19,332,440.66 and a 10 percent pre-awarded Change Order amount of \$1,933,244.066, for an estimated total of \$21,265,684.73.

City Engineer Porter addressed Council thanking Purchasing and the Engineering Department for all of the work they have done on this project. The bid came in at \$4-\$5 million under what was anticipated. McMillen Drive will be closed to through traffic from the beginning of construction until approximately May 2025. Porter added residents who live along this section will still have access to their homes, it will just be prohibited through traffic. Shutting down the road during construction saved millions of dollars and at least six months of construction time.

Council Comments

Mayor Porter asked for a general timeline on when utilities will start moving and the actual construction of the road will begin. City Engineer Porter replied they would like to start construction toward the beginning of November,

anticipate a year and a half (May or June 2025) before substantial completion for the road to open, and final completion would be about six months later (November 2025). Mayor *pro tem* Forrester emphasized a savings of \$4 million to the taxpayers on the bond. Council thanked staff for the work they have done on this project.

Council Action

A motion was made by Mayor *pro tem* Forrester, seconded by Councilman Williams, to approve Item 3 as presented. A vote was taken and the motion passed 6-0 with Councilman Strang absent.

4. Consider, and act upon, the approval of #W2023-86-I Senior Recreation Center Renovation to LMC Corporation in the amount of \$736,877.17 through a cooperative purchasing contract with BuyBoard (#660-21) and authorizing the City Manager to execute any and all necessary documents.

Staff Comments

Senior Buyer Rodriguez addressed the Council stating staff recommends the award of a contract for Senior Recreation Center Renovations to LMC Corporation for \$736,877.17 as providing the best value to the City.

Parks and Recreation Assistant Director Stowers addressed the Council stating this project will include a full interior renovation, and with financial savings, added parking and exterior finishes to resemble the recently renovated Public Safety Building. Items to be renovated are as follows: new ADA restrooms, expansion of the senior fitness center with surfacing to match the Recreation Center, all new flooring throughout the building, upgrade to the HVAC system to rezone common areas and office spaces, relocating staff offices, and new LED lighting throughout the building.

Council Comments

Mayor Porter thanked staff for their work and for the cost savings which allows the City to get more for the money. Stowers added originally, they were looking at a three-month-long construction project; however, they are anticipating up to six months now. Porter asked if there was a plan that would allow the senior citizens to still be able to gather. Stowers replied yes, they will have open play time at the Recreation Center. Mayor *pro tem* Forrester stated he would like to see a scheduling of activities similar to what they currently do so they do not experience a change in services being provided. Stowers replied that staff could look into it, and added that as of right now they do not have anything programmed. Forrester asked if specific times could be set aside at the Recreation Center for senior citizens to give them the same accommodations that they currently receive. Parks and Recreation Director Powlen replied that during the time in the day when open play is occurring at the Recreation Center, there are usually seniors utilizing the equipment time and will have access to the track. Forrester asked if accessing equipment becomes an issue and, if staff could look at making changes. Powlen replied that the staff would monitor that.

Council Action

A motion was made by Mayor Porter, seconded by Councilman Williams, to approve Item 4 as presented. A vote was taken and the motion passed 6-0 with Councilman Strang absent.

5. Consider, and act upon, Resolution No. 2023-23(R) casting a nomination for a candidate for the Board of Directors of the Dallas Central Appraisal District.

Council Comments

Mayor Porter stated there are specific requirements listed in the agenda packet for a candidate, and added if the Council does not have an individual to recommend, the Council is not required to take action.

Discussion

City Socratory

Article III, Section 9 of the City of Wylie Home Rule Charter states that the City Council shall hold at least one regular meeting each month and as many additional meetings as it deems necessary to transact the business of the City. By this Ordinance, the dates and times of all regular meetings in 2024 will be set. During the months of November and December one meeting per month has been scheduled due to the holidays. Upon request of the Council, special called meetings and work sessions can be scheduled at any times designated by the City Council and posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-49

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WYLIE, TEXAS, HEREBY SETTING THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING DATES FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2024 FOR THE CITY OF WYLIE, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR SAVINGS, REPEALING AND SEVERANCE CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council normally meets on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter requires the City Council to meet at least once each month; and

WHEREAS, many citizens, City employees and elected officials take vacations or are unavailable during the holidays; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it will be beneficial and in the best interests of the public to set forth its regular meeting dates for the calendar year 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WYLIE, TEXAS:

<u>SECTION 3</u>: The City Council's regular meetings shall generally begin at 6:00 p.m. and are usually held at 300 Country Club Road, Building #100, Wylie, Texas in the City Council Chambers in City Hall; however, the exact time and location for each meeting shall be posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

SECTION 4: Savings/ Repealing Clause. All provisions of any Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed Ordinance, nor shall the repeal prevent prosecution from being commenced for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the Ordinance. Any remaining portions of conflicting Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 5</u>: <u>Severability</u>. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Wylie hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or

phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 6: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

(An Amended Wylie Jail Services Agreement)

First Amendment to Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Jail Services

This First Amendment to Interlocal Cooperation Agreement ("<u>First Amendment</u>") is entered into by and between the City of Parker, Texas, a Type A General Law municipality ("<u>Parker</u>") and the City of Wylie, Texas, a Home-Rule municipality ("<u>Wylie</u>"). Wylie and Agency are at times each referred to herein as a "party" or collectively as the "<u>parties</u>."

RECITALS:

- 1. The parties entered into that certain Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated January 12, 2022, which is incorporated herein by reference for all purposes ("Original Agreement"), and together with this First Amendment, (the "Agreement"), wherein Agency contracted with Wylie to obtain jail services from Wylie at the Wylie Jail for the handling, processing, housing and detention of persons arrested by the Parker Police Department.
- 2. The parties desire to amend the Original Agreement as set forth in this First Amendment and to otherwise agree as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, and for other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1: Amendment to Original Agreement, Section 3.01 (Jail Fees):

Section 3.01 (Jail Fees) of the Original Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3.01 Jail Fees

Agency shall pay to Wylie a fee for each detainee processed into the Wylie Jail and delivered by Agency regardless of the detainee's length of stay ("Detainee Fee"). The amount of the Detainee Fee shall be established by administrative order of the Wylie City Manager on an annual basis for each ensuing fiscal year based upon the projected costs of services; provided, however, the initial Detainee Fee shall be one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) per detainee for the first 24 hour period in custody. Each additional 24-hour period will constitute a separate day and an additional one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125) per detainee will be charged until changed by administrative order of the Wylie City Manager as provided herein. Any increase or change in the amount of the Detainee Fee or other costs of services shall be effective on the forty-fifth (45th) day after Wylie provides written notice thereof to Agency ("Notice of Fee Increase") unless Wylie receives written notice to terminate this Agreement from Agency prior to the expiration of such forty-five (45) day period."

Section 2: Defined Terms

Any term not defined herein shall be deemed to have the same meaning ascribed to it under the Original Agreement.

Section 3: Ratification

The parties hereby ratify and confirm all of the terms, provisions, covenants and conditions of the Original Agreement and acknowledge and agree that the Original Agreement remains in full force and effect, except as amended in this First Amendment.

Section 4: Controlling Agreement

To the extent that any provision contained herein conflicts with the Original Agreement, the provision contained herein shall supersede such conflicting provisions contained in the Original Agreement.

Section 5: Entire Agreement/First Amendment

This First Amendment and the Original Agreement contain the entire agreement of the parties with respect to the matters contained herein. This First Amendment may not be modified or terminated except upon the provisions hereof or by the mutual written agreement of the parties hereto.

Section 6: Authority to Execute

The individuals executing this First Amendment on behalf of the respective parties below represent to each other and to others that all appropriate and necessary action has been taken to authorize the individual who is executing this First Amendment to do so for and on behalf of the party for which his or her signature appears, that there are no other parties or entities required to execute this First Amendment in order for the same to be an authorized and binding agreement on the party for whom the individual is signing this First Amendment and that each individual affixing his or her signature hereto is authorized to do so, and such authorization is valid and effective on the Effective Date.

Section 7: Counterparts

This First Amendment may be executed in a number of identical counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original for all purposes, and all such counterparts shall, collectively, constitute one First Amendment. An electronic mail or facsimile signature will also be deemed to constitute an original if properly executed and delivered to the other party.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this First Amendment and caused this First Amendment to be effective when all the parties have signed it. The date this First Amendment is signed by the last party to sign it (as indicated by the date associated with that party's signature below) will be deemed the effective date of this First Amendment.

Discussion

The Parks and Recreation Department is seeking approval from City Council to award a contract to RFL, a CorWorth Company, to construct and install new restroom/mechanical rooms at Community Park and East Meadow Trailhead.

This project will include the construction and installation of a new restroom facility for the splash pad and surrounding amenities at Community Park. The existing restroom facility will be removed and replaced with the same number of fixtures, and the orientation will be changed to face the new splash pad. The same restroom/mechanical room will be constructed and installed at East Meadow Trailhead for the future splash pad that will be installed in early summer 2024.

Staff recommends the award of contract W2024-01-I Community Park and East Meadow Restrooms to RFL, a CorWorth Company, in the amount of \$670,900.00 as providing the best value to the City. The City is authorized to purchase from a cooperative purchasing program with another local government or a local cooperative organization pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code and Section 271 Subchapter F of the Local Government Code; and by doing so satisfies any State Law requiring local governments to seek competitive bids for items.

Recommendation

Discussion

In the fall of 2022 the Wylie Baseball Softball Association reached out to the Parks and Recreation Department about the possibility of adding artificial turf to the homeplate circles and a small portion in front of the pitching mounds at the baseball fields located at Community Park. The Association agreed that they would pay for the materials and installation as a donation if the Department would handle the project.

The Department agreed that these areas were ideal for the amount of wear and tear that the homeplate circles and pitching mounds received. City Council approved a budget amendment in October 2022 to utilize up to \$50,000 from the Acquisition and Improvement Fund-Central Zone, which is where Community Park is located. The purpose of the budget amendment was for the Department to move forward with the project, and to have the Association donate the cost in full after the project was complete.

After researching several vendors staff move forward with DFW Turf Solutions, and was able to complete the project for \$42,268.20. The installation of the artificial turf was completed in late summer of 2023, just in time for the fall baseball season to start. The Parks and Recreation Department is now moving forward with the donation process, and recommends City Council to approve the Wylie Baseball Softball Association for the donation of \$42,268.20 to be placed back into the Acquisition and Improvement Fund-Central Zone.

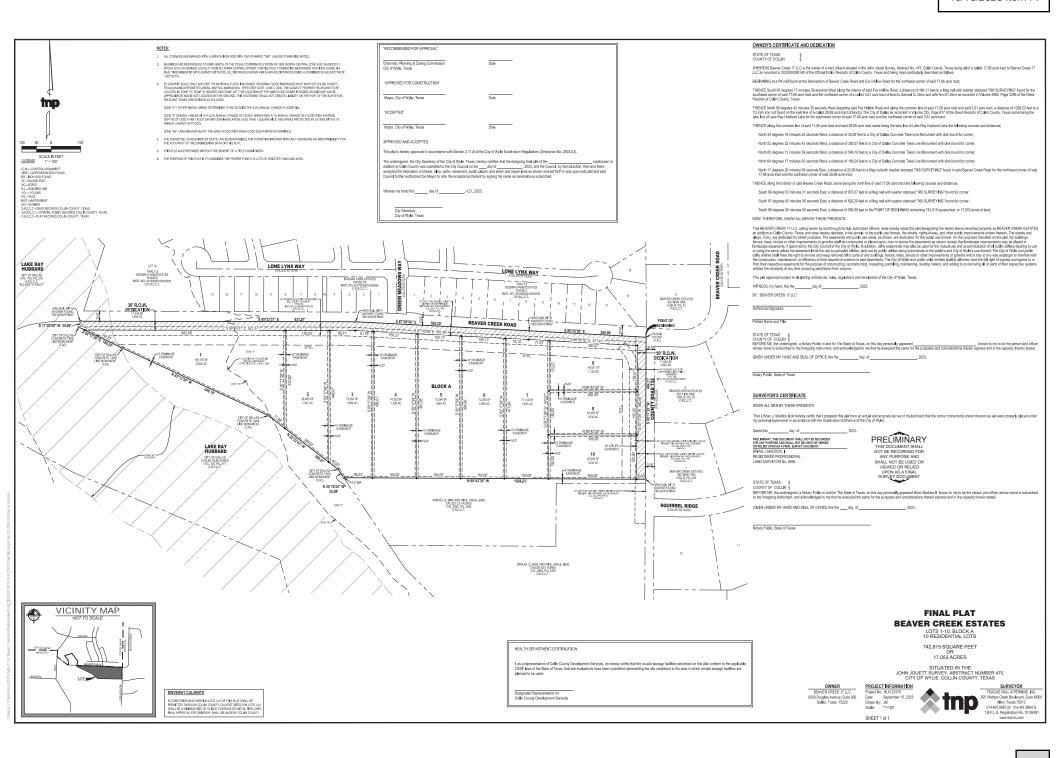

The Owner/Applicant is proposing to construct a new residential dwelling on a single lot. In accordance with Ordinance No. 2022-34, any development proposing new construction or substantial renovation requires special oversight by the Commission to ensure preservation of the historic and architectural character of the District.

The applicant is proposing to construct a 2,193 sf single story Craftsman style residential dwelling on 0.12073 acres (5,259 sf). The design includes an 8:12 pitch gable roof, a 4' open front porch with tapered square columns, and American craftsman standard glass multi-pane windows. The primary exterior material shall be horizontal Hardi Board siding with a width between four and five inches.

The selected paint colors will be from Sherwin Williams Historic Color Palette:

Siding: Roycroft Vellum SW 2833 Trim: Classical White SW 2829

Wavy Decorative Shingles: Craftsman Brown SW 2835

Planning

As stated in the book *A Field Guide to American Houses* by Virginia Savage McAlester, identifying features of a Craftsman style house typically includes low-pitched, gabled roof with wide, unenclosed eave overhang; roof rafters usually exposed; decorative false beams or braces commonly added under gables; porches, either full or partial width; with roof supported by tapered square columns; columns or piers frequently extend to ground-level (without a break at level of porch floor); commonly one or one-half stories high, although two story examples occur in every subtype.

The single-family dwelling will conform to the design standards of Article 6.3 as well as other City ordinances and guidelines. Staff Recommends approval subject to additions and alterations as required by City Engineer and Building Inspections Department.

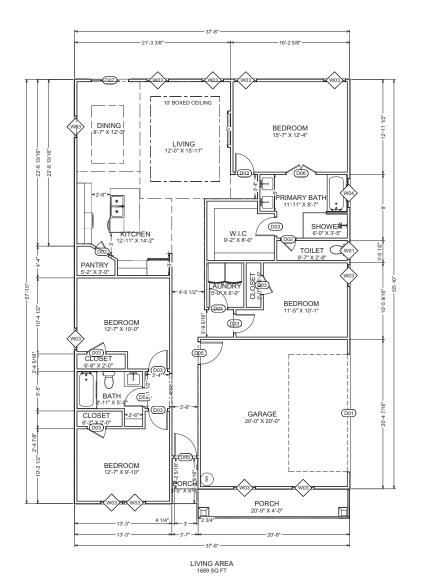
History of property

It is believed that the property was platted sometime between the late 1940's to mid-1950's. A 1921 Sanborn Map shows a structure on the property. It is unknown when the structure was demolished.

If approved, work will begin October 15th with an approximate completion date of seven months.

HRC Recommendation

After some discussion regarding setbacks, the attached garage, and the lack of a porch railing, in which staff explained that the presented plan followed the requirements of the Zoning Ordinance except the railing, the Commission voted 4-1 to recommend approval with the condition that a porch railing be added. The railing has been added and is shown in the exhibit.

Discussion

OWNER: Scott Residential APPLICANT: Dr. Abdul Lateef Khan

The applicant is requesting a change in zoning on 25 acres from Agricultural (AG/30) to 17.2 acres of land to be zoned Single Family 10/24 (SF10/24), 3.8 acres zoned Townhouse District (TH), and 4.0 acres zoned Commercial Corridor (CC). The property is generally located near 605 Country Club Road north of Fire Station #2 and south of Presidential Estates. The applicant is requesting straight zoning in all zoning districts with no exceptions requested; therefore, should the request be approved, all development will be in compliance with the Zoning Ordinance design standards.

The development generally matches the conceptual plans that were presented at the work session held on April 18th at P&Z and May 9th at City Council, with some modifications based on comments from Commissioners and Council members during the work sessions and staff recommendations.

The single-family portion of the development contains 46 residential lots. The townhome portion contains 30 residential lots. The commercial portion allows for the potential development of approximately 25,000 sq. ft. of commercial space within three separate lots.

The 2.2 acres of open space in the single-family zoning shall be owned and maintained by the Home Owners Association and is proposed to provide two pickle ball courts, a half basketball court, and a playground. There are also common space areas in the townhome area.

The proposed zoning includes the creation of three residential streets with access to Country Club Road. A second point of access is the extension of Washington Place within the Presidential Estates Subdivision that was originally designed for joint access. Based on citizen and Commissioners comments, this access is recommended to be open to emergency response vehicles only.

Country Club Road is categorized as a Type B roadway and is listed as a major thoroughfare within the Thoroughfare Plan, being the highest street capacity, the City maintains. While certain areas of Country Club are busy at certain times of the day, for example, the left turn lane from Country Club to Brown and the right turn lane from Country Club to FM 544, based on the most recent traffic counts, Country Club is under capacity overall. The Comprehensive Plan shows the North Central

Texas Council of Government (NCTCOG) performance measurement for Level-of–Service for the section of Country Club Road adjacent to the subject property being in the "A", "B", and "C" category, defined as traffic flow that moves at or above the posted speed limit. Travel time in this category is not hindered because of congestion because traffic volumes are much less than the actual capacity, with few exceptions at limited times of the day; however, due to citizen and Commissioner's concerns, the recommendation for approval assumes that a Traffic Impact Analysis will be required prior to platting. While it is known that Country Club has capacity, the TIA may identify the need for deceleration lanes, or other traffic needs.

The property to the north is developed with the Presidential Estates single-family subdivision. The property to the south is developed with Fire Station #2. The property to the west is developed as a farm and ranch style single-family home. The property to the east is developed with commercial uses and a bus parking area for the Wylie School district. The subject property lies within the Local Commercial and Low Density Residential sectors of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan. The proposed zoning is compatible with the Plan.

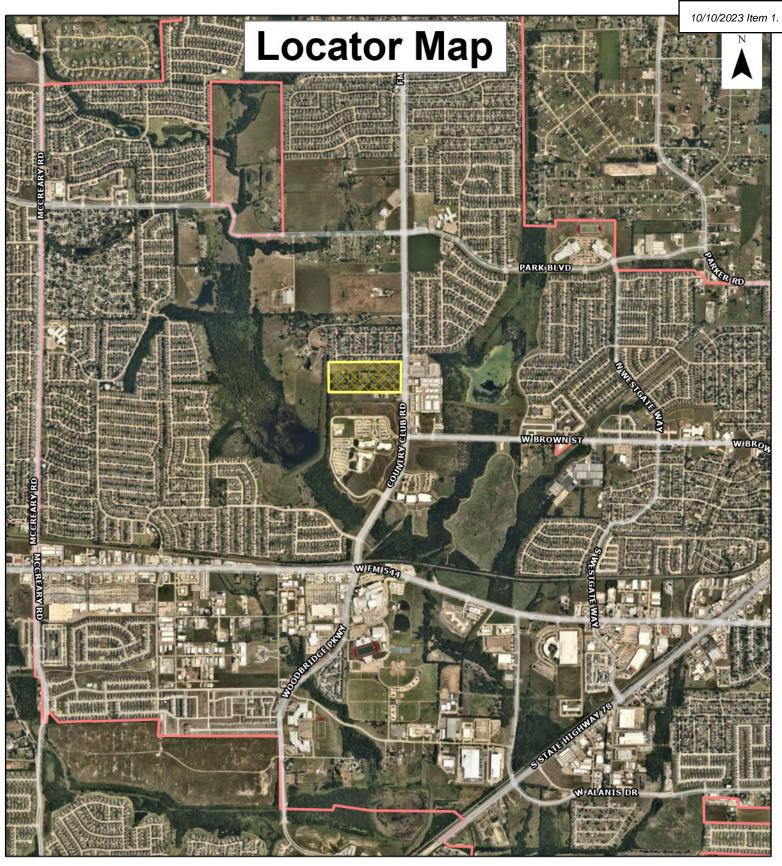
Notices were sent to 41 property owners within 200 feet as required by state law. At the time of posting, nine responses were received in opposition within the notification area and none in favor of the request. Additionally, 32 protest responses were received outside of the notification area.

If zoning is approved, preliminary and final plats shall be required for the entire development. Additionally, site plan review shall be required for the commercial development.

P&Z Recommendation

During the public hearing a majority of citizens against the development expressed concerns that included: concerns about traffic, both on Country Club and within the Presidential Estates neighborhood, potential crime, no need for the commercial zoning, and property values. A few citizens spoke in favor as the development was following the Zoning Ordinance and current future land use plan.

After some discussion centered on citizen comments, the P&Z Commission voted 6-1 to recommend approval with the stipulations that Washington Street access be limited to emergency vehicles only and that a TIA be required prior to platting.



ZONING CASE: ZC 2023-15 College Park

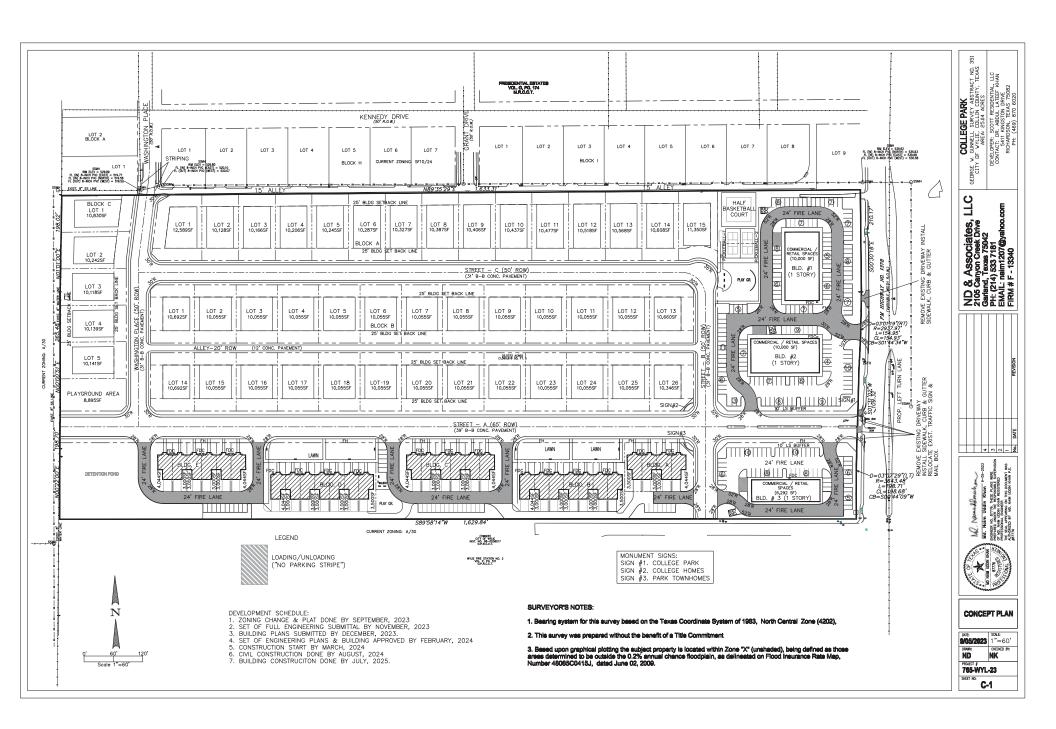

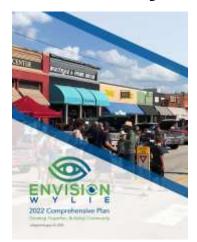

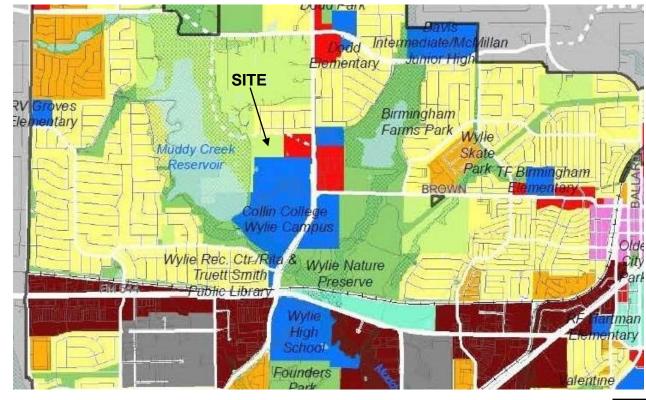
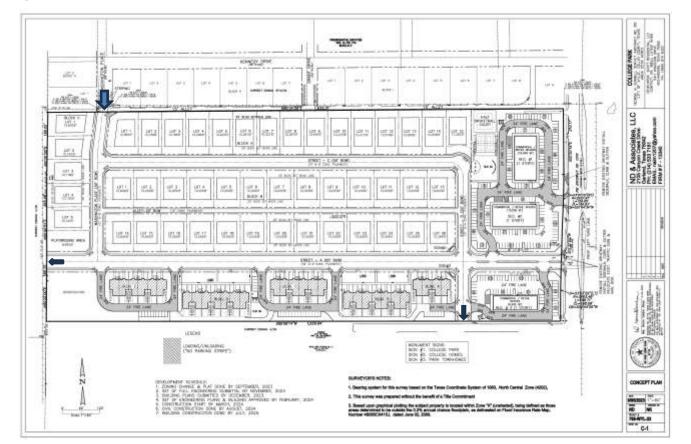


Fig. 5.3 Part Throughfare Plan Fig. 4.6 Part Future Land Use Map (Local Commercial in RED Color)

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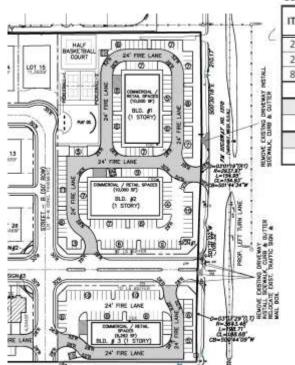

Discussion

OWNER: Asif Anwar APPLICANT: Asif Anwar

The applicant is requesting a Special Use Permit (SUP) on 1.814 acres to allow for a Vape Shop use at 456 Country Club Road, Suite #126. The existing retail suite measures 1,363 sq. ft. The current zoning is Neighborhood Services (NS) and the requested SUP is to allow for Smoke Shop use.

The SUP conditions contain exemptions to the Zoning Ordinance by allowing a smoke shop use within the Neighborhood Services District and allowing for the use to be exempt from the following provisions found in Section 5.2.F.26:

- No smoke shop shall be established within 1,500 feet of another smoke shop.
- Shall not be closer than 300 feet to a public or private school measured in direct line from property line to property line, and in direct lines across intersections, due to Primrose Daycare.

The property to the north is developed with a multi-tenant retail building which contains a smoke shop which was in place before the ordinance amendment requiring SUPs for Smoke Shops. The adjacent property to the south is developed with a convenience store. The property to the east is developed with a daycare center. The property to the west is developed with a community college. The subject property lies within the Local Commercial sector of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan. The proposed zoning is compatible with the Plan.

Notices were sent to six property owners within 200 feet as required by state law. At the time of posting, one response was received in favor and two in opposition.

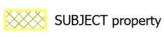
If zoning is approved, a finish out permit for the retail suite and Certificate of Occupancy shall be required prior to the business opening.

P&Z Recommendation

After some discussion regarding the proximity to an existing vape shop and a beer and wine store that also sells tobacco items, and the need to not provide exemptions to a recently passed ordinance, the Commission voted 7-0 to recommend denial. In light of the recommendation, a supermajority vote of Council would be required to approve the request.

Conditions For Special Use Permit

I. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Special Use Permit is to allow for a Smoke Shop use within the Neighborhood Services Zoning District.

II. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- This Special Use Permit shall not affect any regulations of the Neighborhood Services District (NS) set forth in Article 4, Section 4.1 of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance (adopted as of June 2023), except as specifically provided herein.
- 2. The design and development of the House of Vapes development shall be in accordance with Section III below and the Zoning Exhibit (Exhibit B).

III. SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- 1. This Special Use Permit shall allow for a Smoke Shop use within the Neighborhood Services zoning district.
- 2. This Special Use Permit shall be exempt from the following provisions found in Section 5.2.F.26 of the Zoning Ordinance (adopted as of June 2023):

Discussion

The 2021 Bond Election approved \$5M in funding for improvements to the downtown Wylie area. Since that time, City staff has worked with design engineers to perform both a traffic study and drainage study of the subject area and are now ready to move forward with the design of downtown infrastructure to support those study findings.

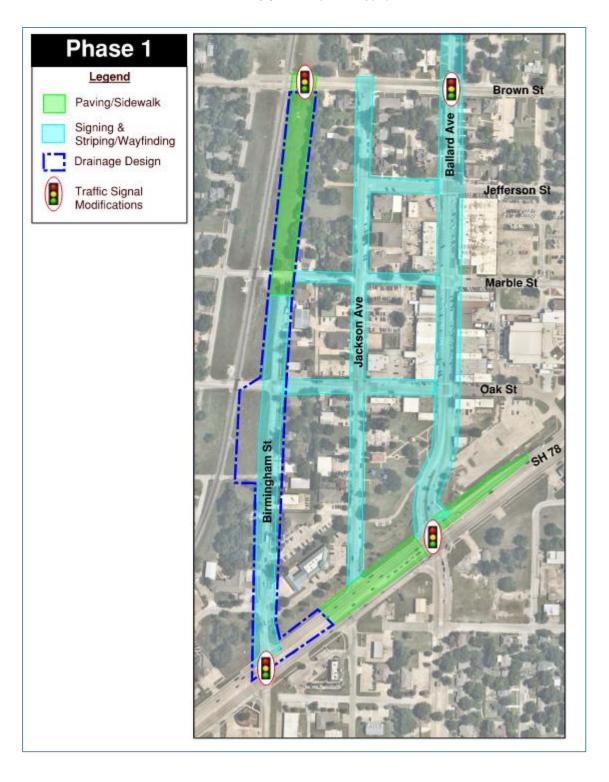
The engineering design scope is a combination of services to identify the look of downtown and establish the one-way routes as outlined and approved by the City Council. The limits of Phase 1 of the Historic Downtown Traffic & Drainage Improvements Project are shown on Exhibit A, and are more specifically outlined below:

- Downtown Implementation Strategy (including Schematics and Theme Development)
- Signal Improvements at four intersections: Brown/Ballard, SH 78/Birmingham, SH 78/Ballard, and Brown/Birmingham.
- Design of Revised Left Turn Lanes on Hwy 78 at Ballard Avenue.
- Storm Drainage Improvements.
- Signing and Striping on existing roadways and proposed one-way configuration.
- Development of Wayfinding Signage and Theme.
- Design of the Extension of Birmingham Street from Marble Street to Brown Street.
- Signal Timing Plans for Downtown Signalized Intersections.
- Bid and Construction Phase Services.

Staff recommends the award of this PSPO to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. as the most qualified firm to provide professional and consulting services for the Historic Downtown Traffic & Drainage Improvements, Phase 1 Project. This PSPO is issued under Master Agreement for Professional and Engineering Services (MAPES) #W2021-8-E. Staff has determined Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to be the most qualified firm for this project in Category J Traffic Engineering, Traffic Planning & Street Lighting, in accordance with Government Code 2254.

Per Texas Property Tax Code Sec. 6.0301: The Appraisal District is governed by a board of directors. Nine directors are appointed by the taxing units that participate in the district as provided by this section. . . To be eligible to serve on the board of directors, an individual . . . must be a resident of the district and must have resided in the district for at least two years immediately preceding the date the individual takes office.

Starting January 1, 2024, the Board of Directors will include three (3) publicly elected directors in addition to the five (5) appointed directors which are still elected by the taxing units that participate in the Appraisal District. Each taxing unit may nominate one to five board candidates. Appointed directors will begin staggered four-year terms on January 1st of even-numbered years, and elected directors will begin staggered four-year terms on January 1st of odd-numbered years. Another significant change in this new section is that the tax assessor-collector is now a voting ex officio member to ensure there are no tie votes.

Per Texas Property Tax Code Sec. 6.03(d): The voting entitlement of a taxing unit that is entitled to vote for directors is determined by dividing the total dollar amount of property taxes imposed in the district by the taxing unit for the preceding tax year by the sum of the total dollar amount of property taxes imposed in the district for that year by each taxing unit that is entitled to vote, by multiplying the quotient by 1,000, and by rounding the product to the nearest whole number. That number is multiplied by the number of directorships to be filled. The City of Wylie's unit number of votes is 53.

Per Texas Property Tax Code Sec. 6.03(g): Each taxing unit . . . that is entitled to vote may nominate by resolution adopted by its governing body one candidate for each position to be filled on the board of directors. The presiding officer of the governing body of the unit shall submit the names of the unit's nominees to the chief appraiser before October 15. **This** election is for a single one-year term to expire on December 31, 2024.

Per Texas Property Tax Code Sec. 6.03(j): Before October 30, the chief appraiser shall prepare a ballot, listing the candidates whose names were timely submitted under Subsection (g) . . .alphabetically according to the first letter in each candidate's surname, and shall deliver a copy of the ballot to the presiding officer of the governing body of each taking unit that is entitled to vote.

There is not a list of candidates for this portion of the Board of Directors election; therefore, Council can nominate who they think would be best.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The purpose of this letter is to provide an overview of the election process, and provide a detailed timeline for each phase for taxing entity appointed Board of Director's members. The process for electing the District's Board of Directors is outlined in the Texas Property Tax Code (TPTC) § 6.03. The deadline dates for the election are statutory and controlled by TPTC § 6.03.

On July 24, 2023, Governor Greg Abbott signed Senate Bill 2 into law which has added TPTC § 6.0301. In accordance with the new section, the District's Board of Directors makeup has changed significantly. The Legislature has seen fit to increase the total number of directors from five (5) appointed and one voting tax assessor-collector director, to nine (9) total directors.

Starting January 1, 2024 the Board of Directors will include three (3) publicly elected directors in addition to the five (5) appointed directors which are still elected by the taxing units that participate in the Appraisal District. Each taxing unit may nominate one to five board candidates. Appointed directors will begin staggered four-year terms on January 1st of even-numbered years, and elected directors will begin staggered four-year terms on January 1st of odd-numbered years. Another significant change in this new section is that the tax assessor-collector is now a voting ex officio member to ensure there are no tie votes.

This election is for a single one-year term to expire on December 31, 2024.

CALENDAR OF EVENTS FOR APPOINTED MEMBERS ON JANUARY 1, 2024

Title of Event: Allocation of Votes

Deadline: Before October 1st, (September 28, 2023)

Action: Calculate the number of votes for each entity and notify the county judge, commissioners of the county, and presiding officers for cities, towns, school districts and college district.

Responsible for Action: Chief Appraiser

Tax Code: 6.03 (e)

Summary of Action: There are 5,000 total votes to be distributed based on tax levy. Each taxing unit's vote allocation is based on their tax levy compared to the grand total levy for all taxing units. Each taxing unit's vote allocation will be delivered to the taxing unit in late-September.

Example: If a taxing unit's tax levy calculates to be 10% of the grand total levy for all taxing units, the taxing unit would be allocated 500 votes.

Title of Event: Nomination of Candidates

Deadline: Before October 15th, (since October 14th is a Saturday the deadline will shift to next business day). **Deadline for delivery of nominating Resolution, received by** the Chief Appraiser, is end-of-day October 16, 2023.

Action: Nominate up to one (1) candidate for each position to be filled on the Board of Directors. All five (5) of the board positions are included in this election, therefore each taxing unit can nominate a maximum of five (5) candidates.

Responsible for Action: Governing body of each entity and entity's presiding officer.

Tax Code: 6.03 (g)

Summary of Action: A taxing unit's nomination(s) by written Resolution can be submitted at any time, as long as it is received by the Chief Appraiser by end-of-day October 16, 2023. The Resolution must include the name and address of each candidate nominated. To be eligible to serve on the board, an individual must be a resident of the district and must have resided in the district for at least two years immediately preceding the date they take office.

Note: This is the nominations part of the process and the written Resolution associated with this phase of the election should only include nominations of candidates.

Title of Event: Delivery of Ballots

Deadline: Before October 30th, (Since October 29th is a Sunday, the deadline will shift to the next business day.) **Deadline for delivery of ballots is end-of-day October 30**, **2023**.

Additionally, each ballot will list the taxing unit name and their vote allocation. The ballots will be mailed the third week of October.

<u>Special Action (Tax Code Amendment):</u> Taxing Units with 5% or more of the total votes MUST determine its votes by Resolution adopted at the <u>FIRST</u> or <u>SECOND</u> OPEN meeting of the governing body held after the Chief Appraiser delivers the ballot and the Resolution must be submitted to the chief appraiser not later than the <u>THIRD</u> day following the date the Resolution was adopted. Taxing units with 250 or more votes are affected by this Tax Code change.

Responsible for Action: Governing of each entity and entity's presiding officer.

Tax Code: 6.03 (g), 6.03 (k and k-1 effective 1-1-2022)

Summary of Action: The governing body of each taxing unit entitled to vote shall determine its vote by Resolution. If an entity marks their votes next to the nominees name on the Ballot received from the Chief Appraiser, the marked Ballot must have an accompanying Resolution adopted in a public meeting determining the tax unit's votes. The Resolution adopted in an open meeting of the taxing unit, or a copy of marked Ballot accompanied by the taxing unit's voting Resolution must be received by the Chief Appraiser by end-of-day December 14, 2023. Taxing units with 250 or more votes, please refer to the "Special Action (Tax Code Amendment)" section above concerning the deadlines for adopting your vote Resolution and submitting the Resolution to the Chief Appraiser.

Title of Event: Election Results

Deadline: Before December 31st, (December 30, 2023)

Action: Count the votes and declare the five (5) candidates who receive the largest

cumulative vote totals elected to a four-year term, beginning January 1, 2024.

Responsible for Action: Chief Appraiser

Tax Code: 6.03 (k)

Summary of Action: The Chief Appraiser will submit the election results before

December 31, 2023 to each taxing unit and to the candidates.
