




### Authority to Plan








# Detailed SWOT Exercise

#### **Opportunities**

Elements in the environment that the City could exploit to its advantage.

#### **Threats**

Elements in the environment that pose an issue for the City.

# Housing and Neighborhoods



#### **Consider:**

- Is there an appropriate mix of housing types? If not, what is needed?
- Is more dense housing (apartments, mixed use, townhomes etc.) needed in the City? Is it appropriate?
- Are existing neighborhoods in need of repair?

# Land Use and Design



#### **Consider:**

- Where should future residential or nonresidential development be?
- Are there issues with land use conflicts?

### Transportation



#### **Consider:**

- Where does traffic congestion exist?
- Are more connections needed? Where?
- Are there maintenance issues on certain roads?
