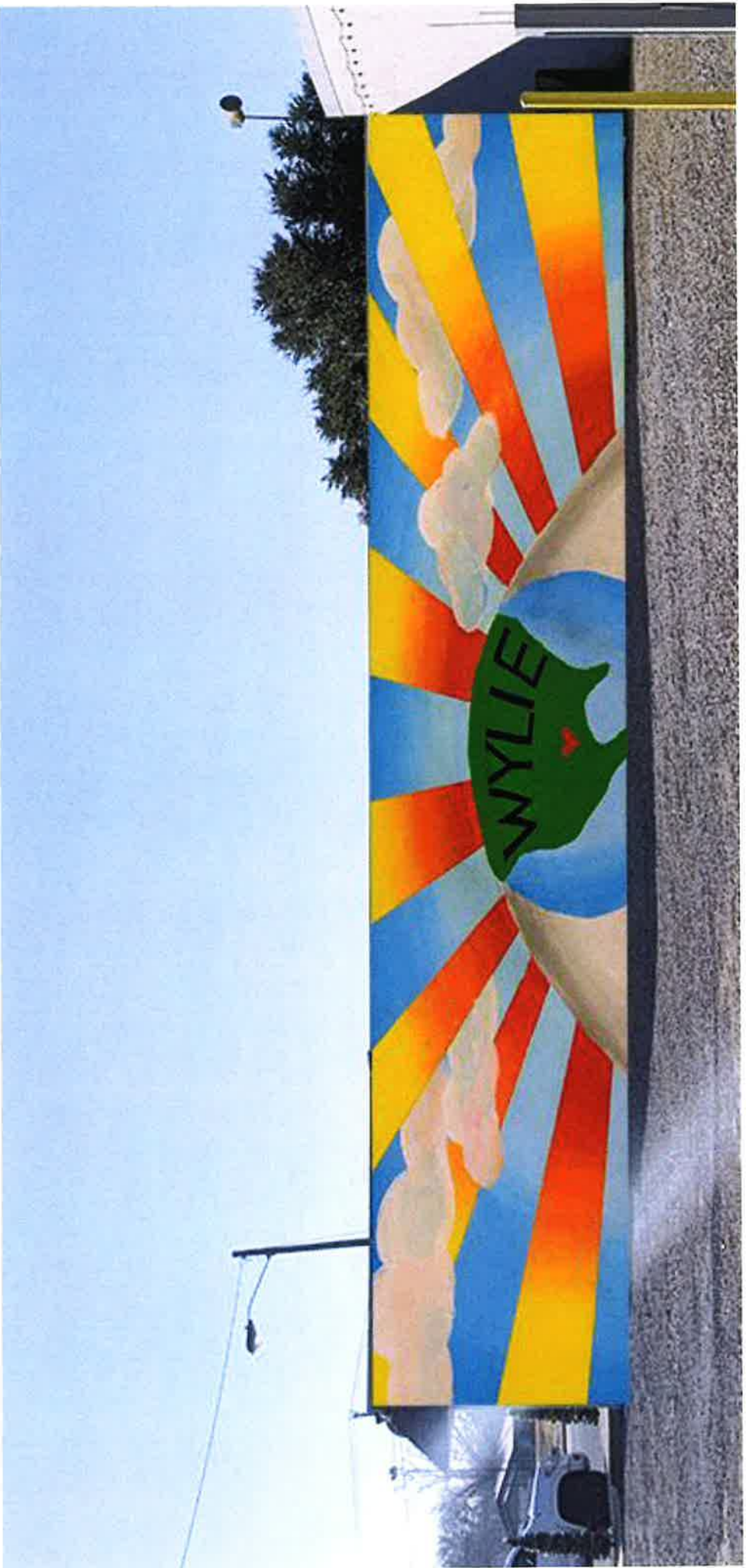
# Shea Ameen

# Marina Godkin

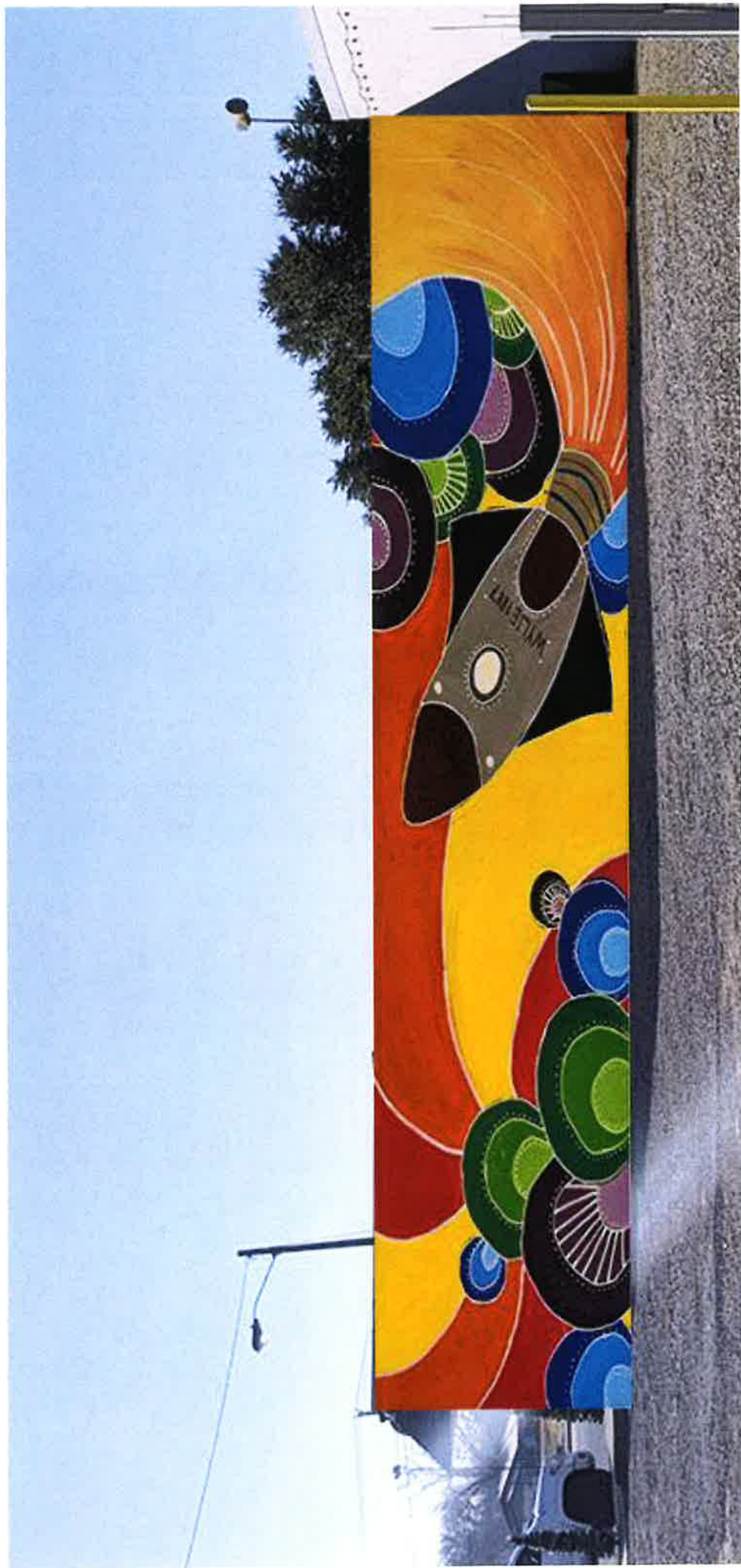
