Board Discussion

PAAB Liaison Pannell updated the board that artist Wright is working to finalize a revised set of mound design plans. The pavers in the original design do not fall within his original budget, and the revised design will help with cost savings and overall maintenance issues. The revised design will be sent to Wright's architect for structural review, and then stamped by an engineer before work on the mounds is set to begin.

B. Walking Trails Phase 3, (Sonny Behan) Update.

Board Discussion

PAAB Liaison Pannell informed the board that artist Behan's "Echoes on the Prairie" statue has completed bronzing and is assembled and standing erect on its base. Behan will paint the base and deer and prepare the statue for shipping from South Africa in the coming weeks.

PAAB Liaison Pannell shared that Seth Venable's "Native American Hunter" has been cast in bronze and is in the assembly phase. Patina will be applied once assembly is complete.
